1. Speed
2. Following to Close
3. Inattention
4. Fail to Remain in Lane
5. Improper Lane Change
6. Fail to Yield Right of Way
7. Improper Turn
8. Disregard Sign/Signal
9. Drinking Alcohol
10. Sleep/Fatigue

### Top Ten Car Driver at Fault (versus CMV) Errors:

1. Following to Close
2. Fail to Yield Right of Way
3. Fail to Remain in Lane
4. Driving too Fast for Conditions
5. Disregard Sign/Signal
6. Inattention
7. Improper Passing
8. Drinking Alcohol
9. Sleep/Fatigue
10. Improper Turn
