Re: Approval of the Willamette Basin Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Addendum #1

Dear Mr. Mullane:

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality submitted the Willamette Basin TMDL (2006) Addendum #1 to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) on October 14, 2011. Addendum #1 is a modification to the temperature wasteload allocation for the City of Jefferson. Following our review of the TMDL and supplemental information, the EPA is pleased to approve the revision to the Willamette Basin TMDL.

Our review indicates that the revised wasteload allocation for the City of Jefferson WWTP has been established at a level that, when fully implemented, will lead to the attainment of the water quality standards addressed by these TMDLs. By the EPA's approval, these TMDLs are now incorporated into the State of Oregon's Continuing Planning Process under §303(e) of the Clean Water Act.
