Subject: Klamath Air Quality Advisory Committee

Summary

DEQ is putting together an Advisory Committee to review and confirm air quality strategies to maintain the attainment status of Klamath Falls with the PM_{2.5} standard and complete the 10-year maintenance plan for PM 2.5.

DEQ Staff Roles

Tori Heroux, Air Quality Planning Section, is the lead planner working on the Klamath Falls PM 2.5 Maintenance Plan. Tori is also facilitating the Klamath Falls Advisory Committee.

Committee Purpose

DEQ is assembling an advisory committee for the Maintenance Plan. The purpose of this committee is to evaluate emission contributions and effectiveness of reductions from all emission source categories and determine whether existing control measures are sufficient to maintain NAAQS compliance with a margin of safety to account for likely future reductions to the standard. The Committee will also review the effectiveness of existing contingency measures and develop implementation strategies for such measures.
