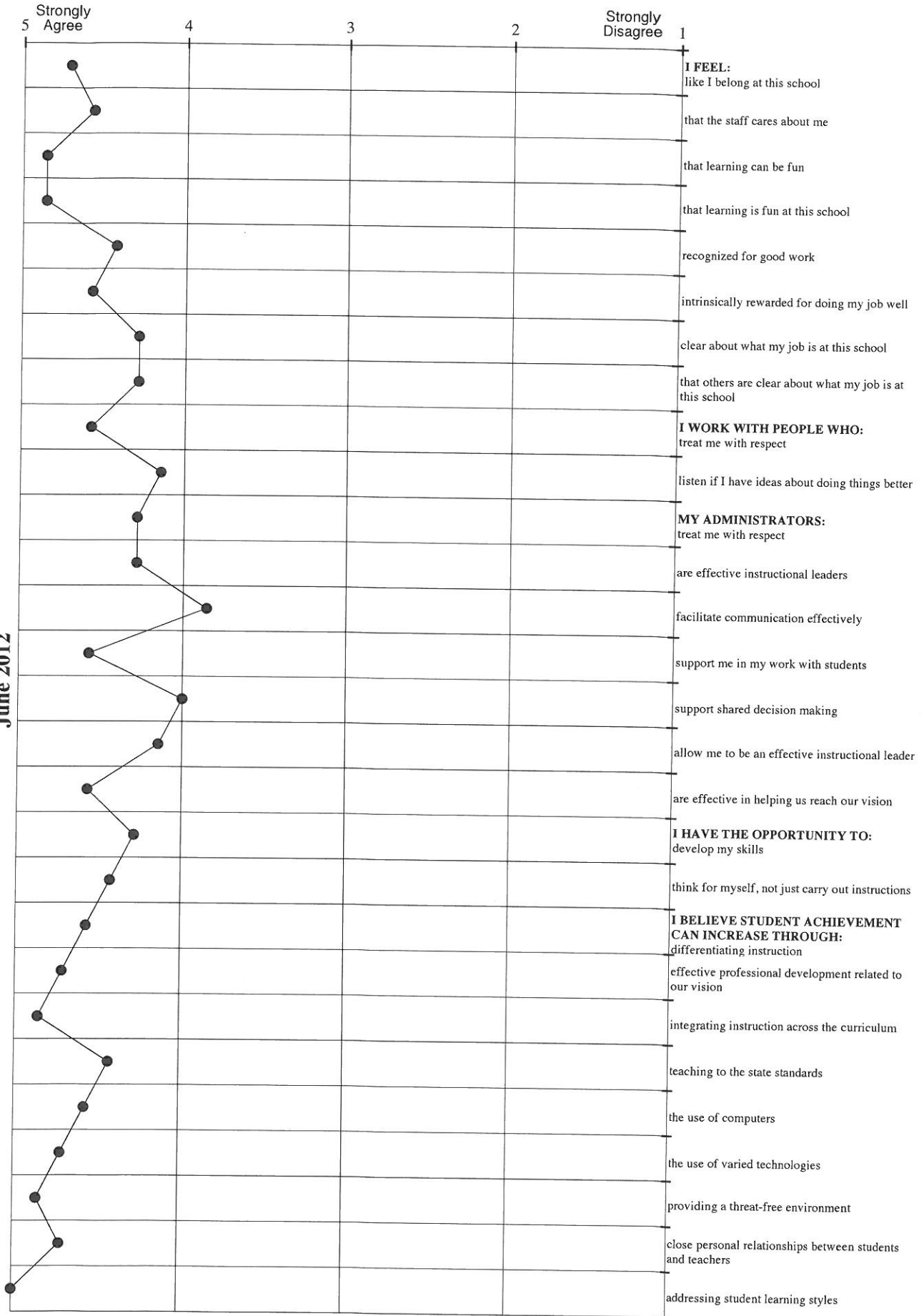
## Four Rivers Community School

Even though our data set is small, 2011-2012 will give us a baseline and we will continue to measure our growth against the initial numbers.

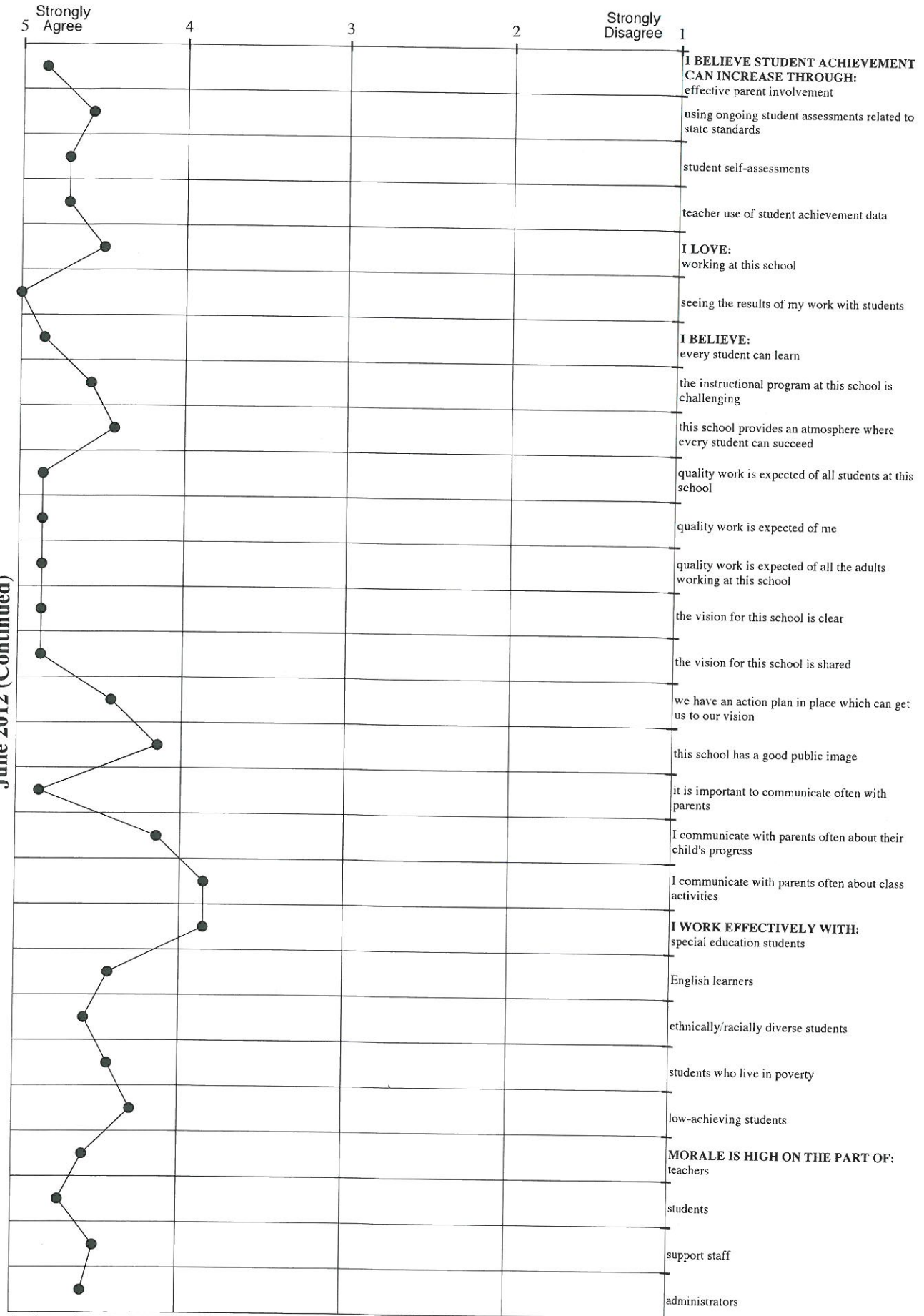

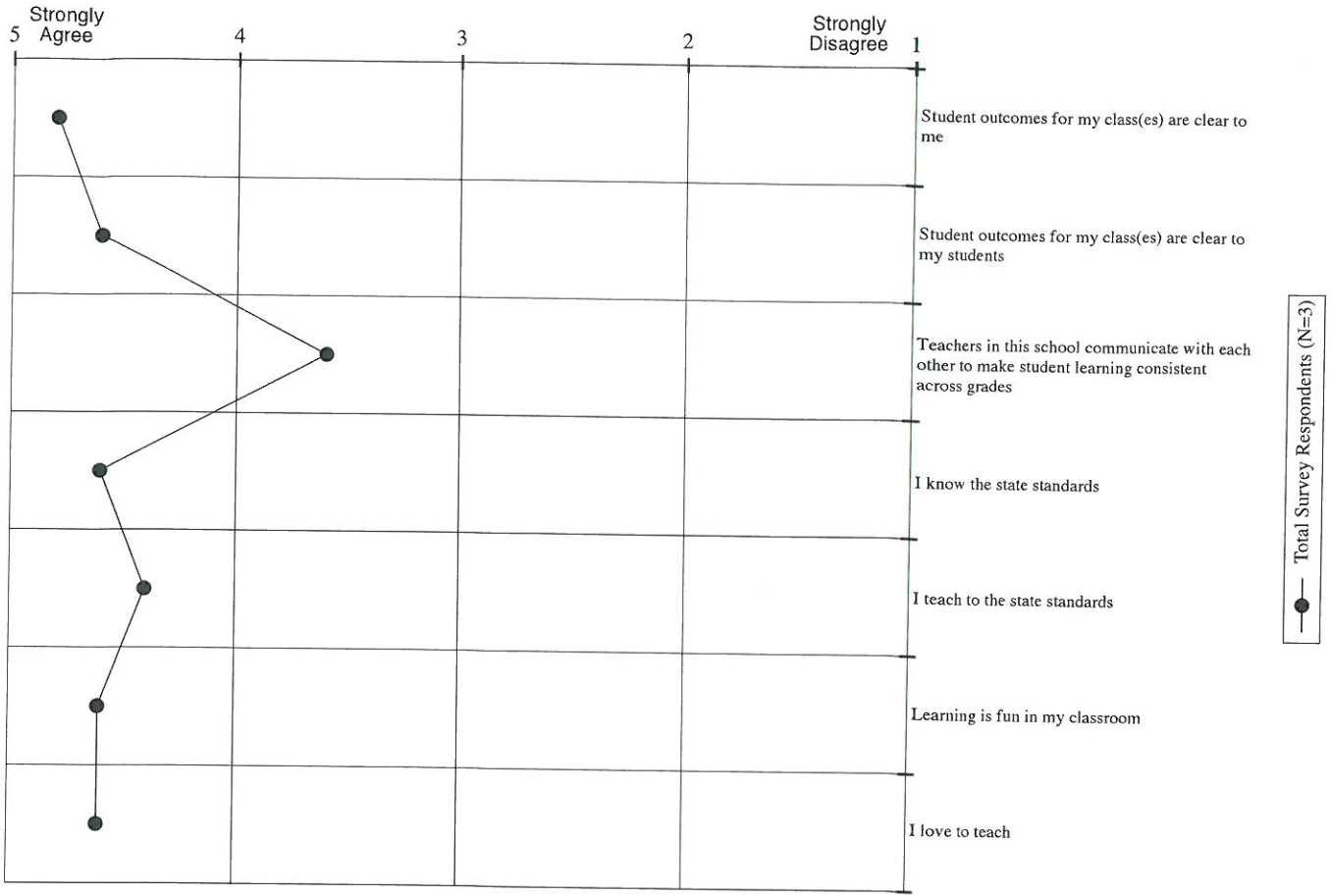
**Four Rivers Community School Staff Responses**

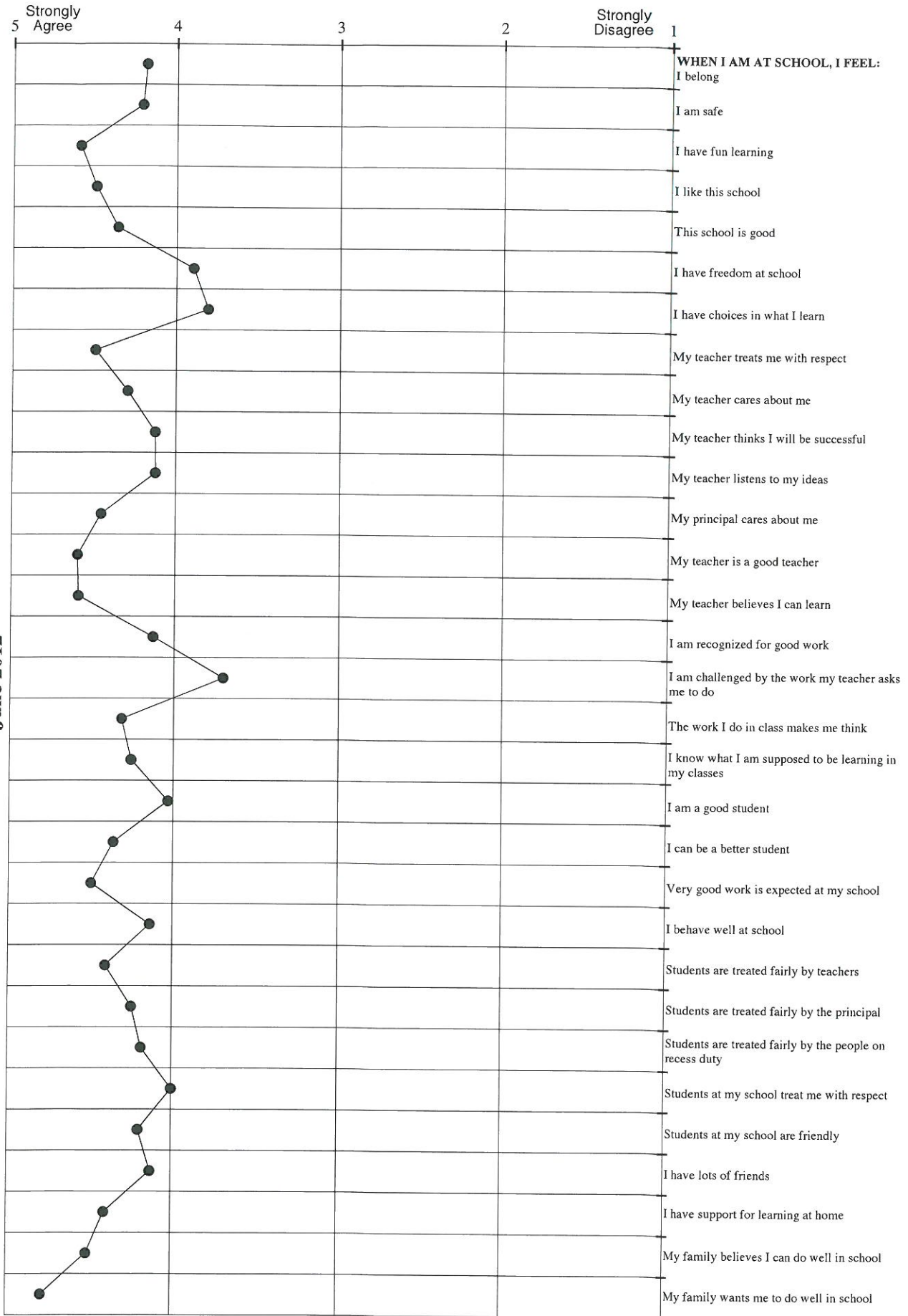
**1. What are the strengths of this school?**

**2. What needs to be improved?**

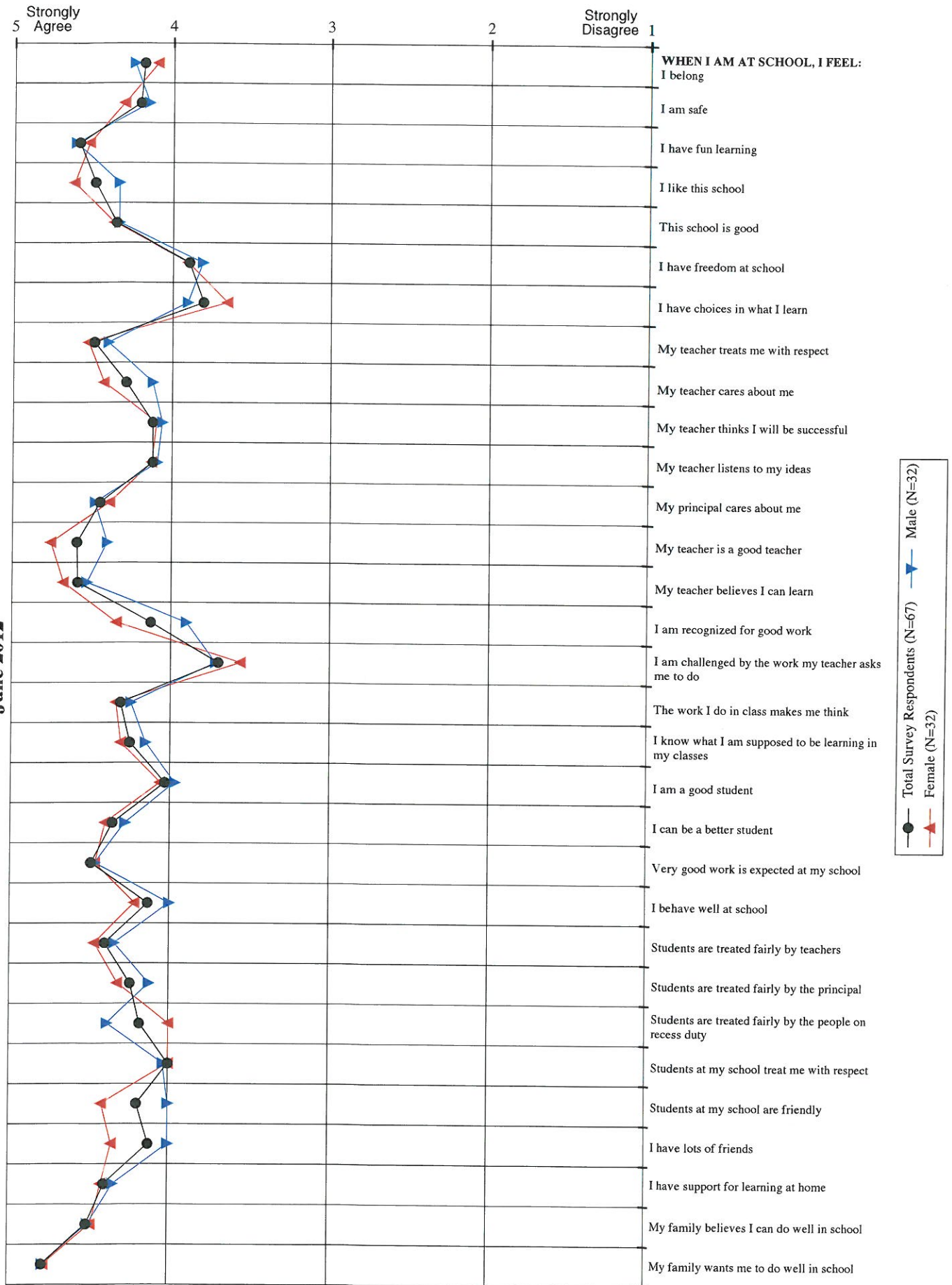
- Need facility for gym.

**Four Rivers Community School Student Responses June 2012**



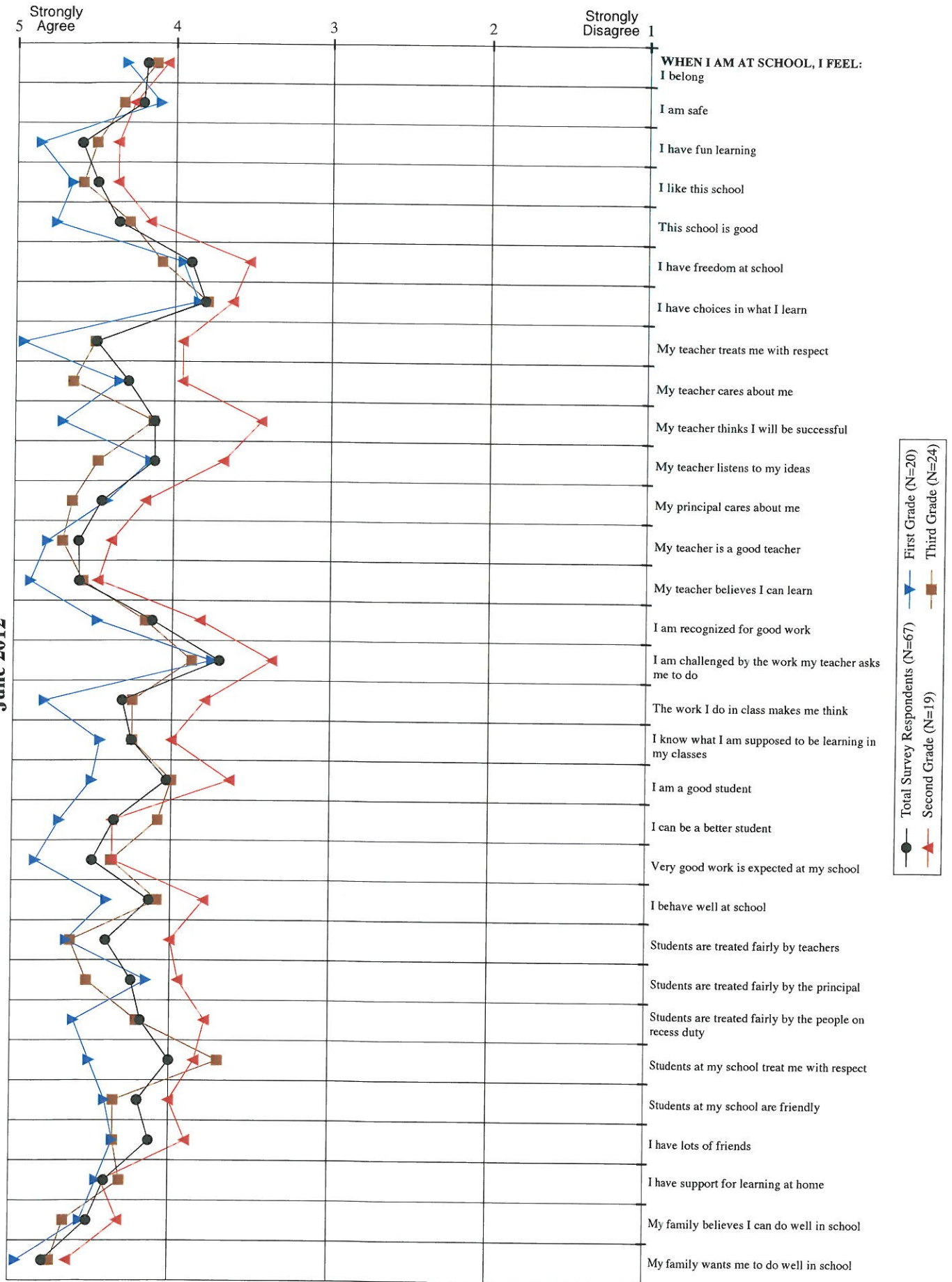

**Four Rivers Community School Student Responses by Gender June 2012**

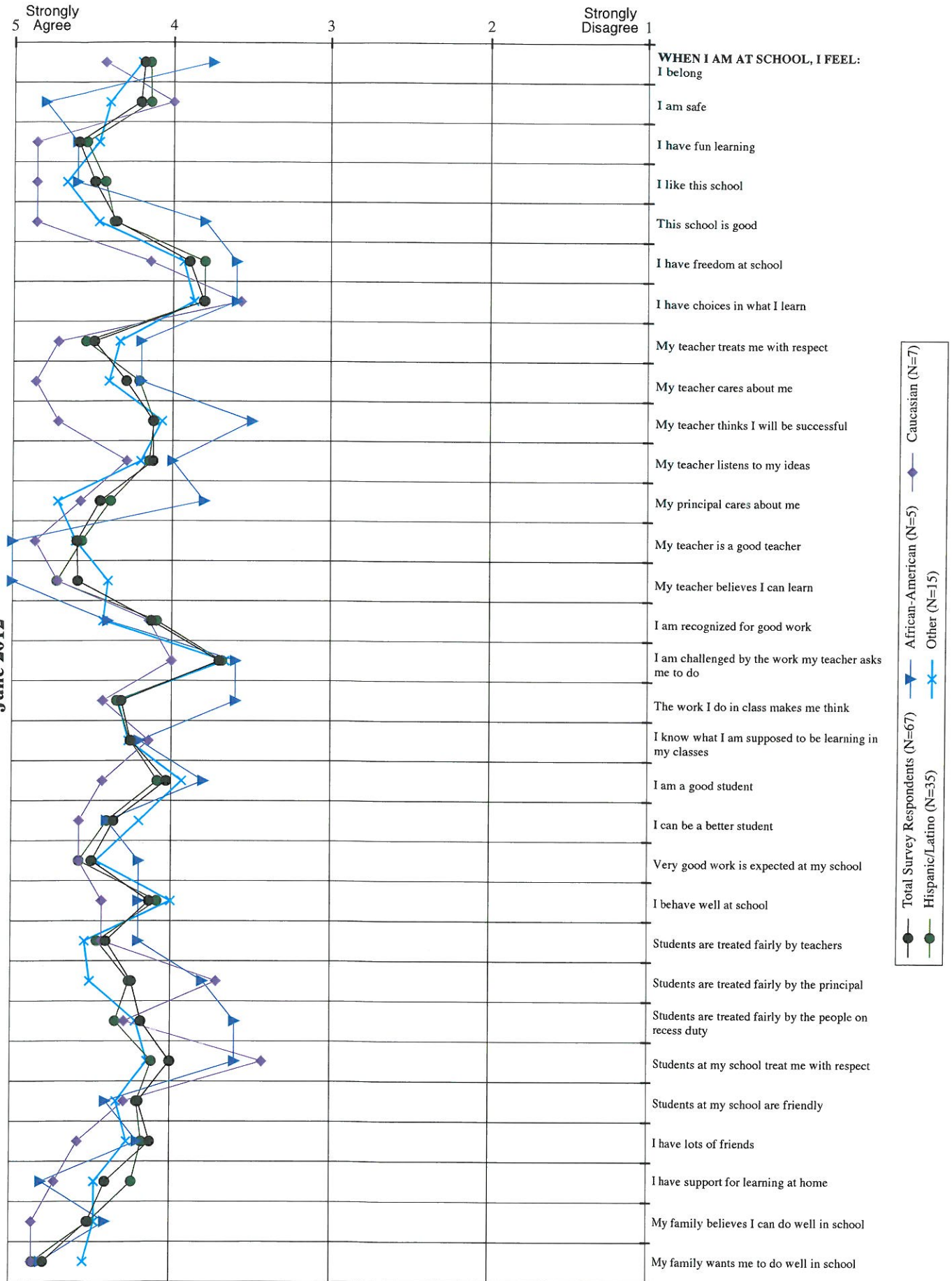




**Four Rivers Community School Student Responses by Grade June 2012**

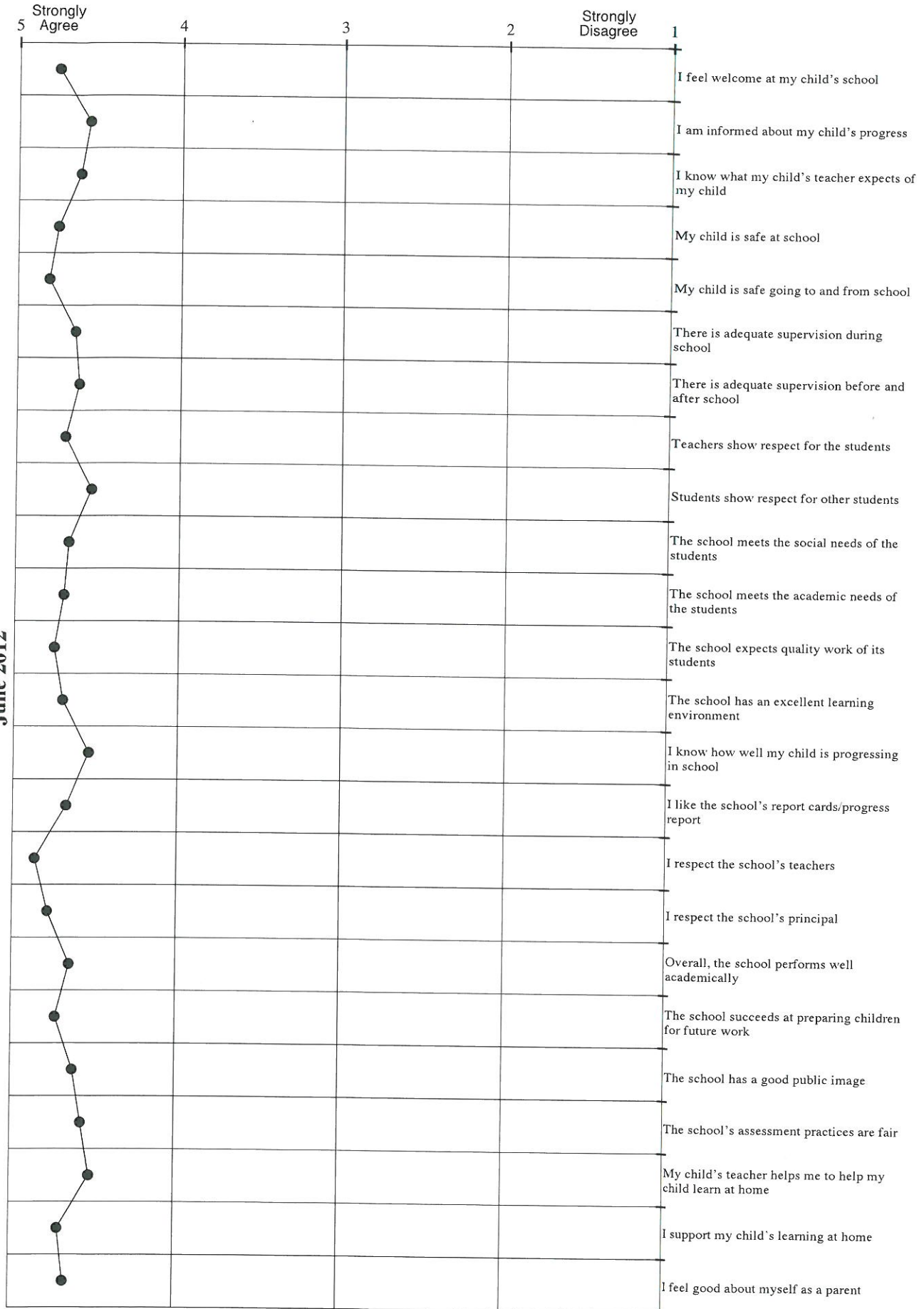

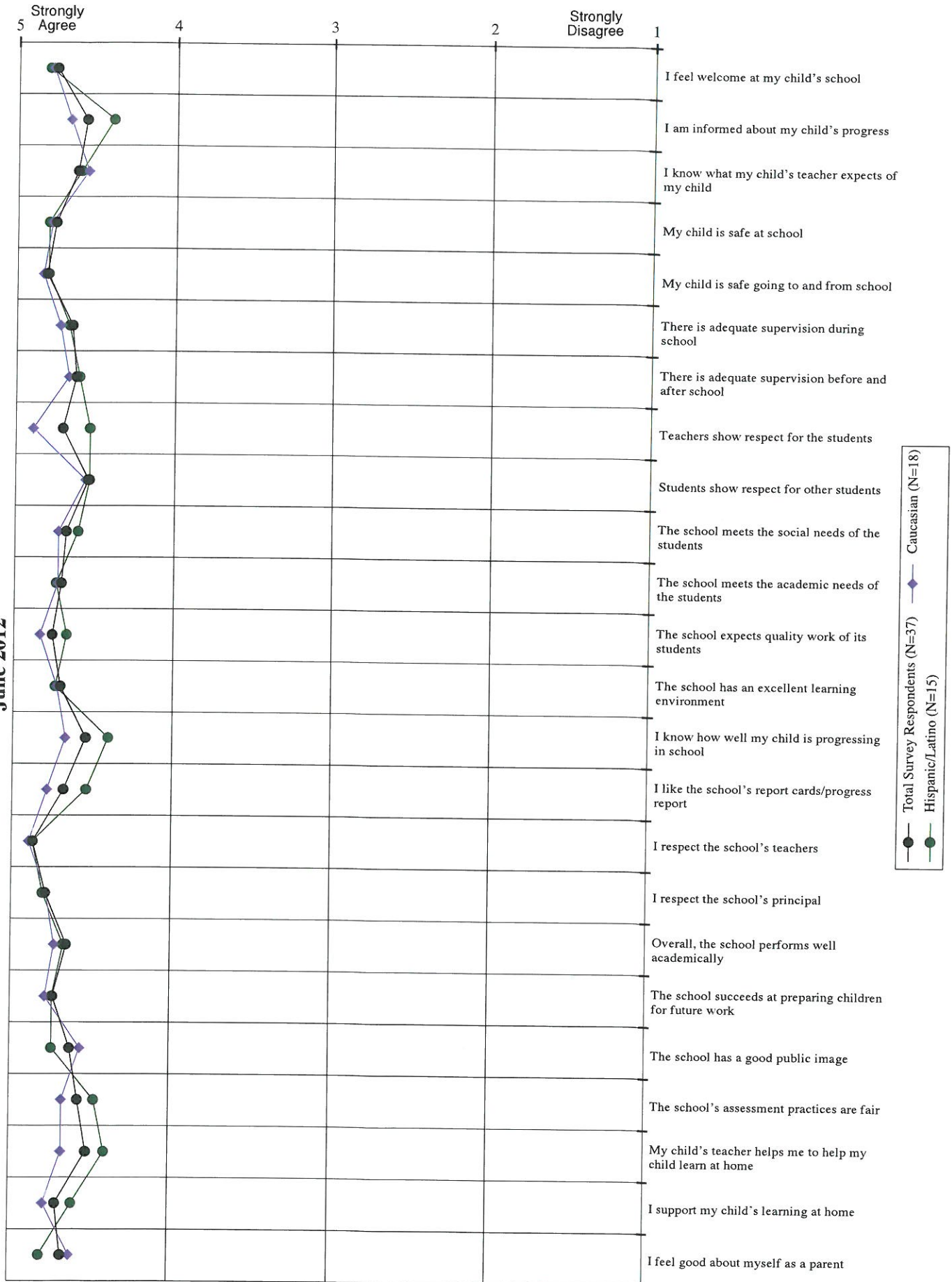

**Four Rivers Community School Parent Responses by Ethnicity June 2012**

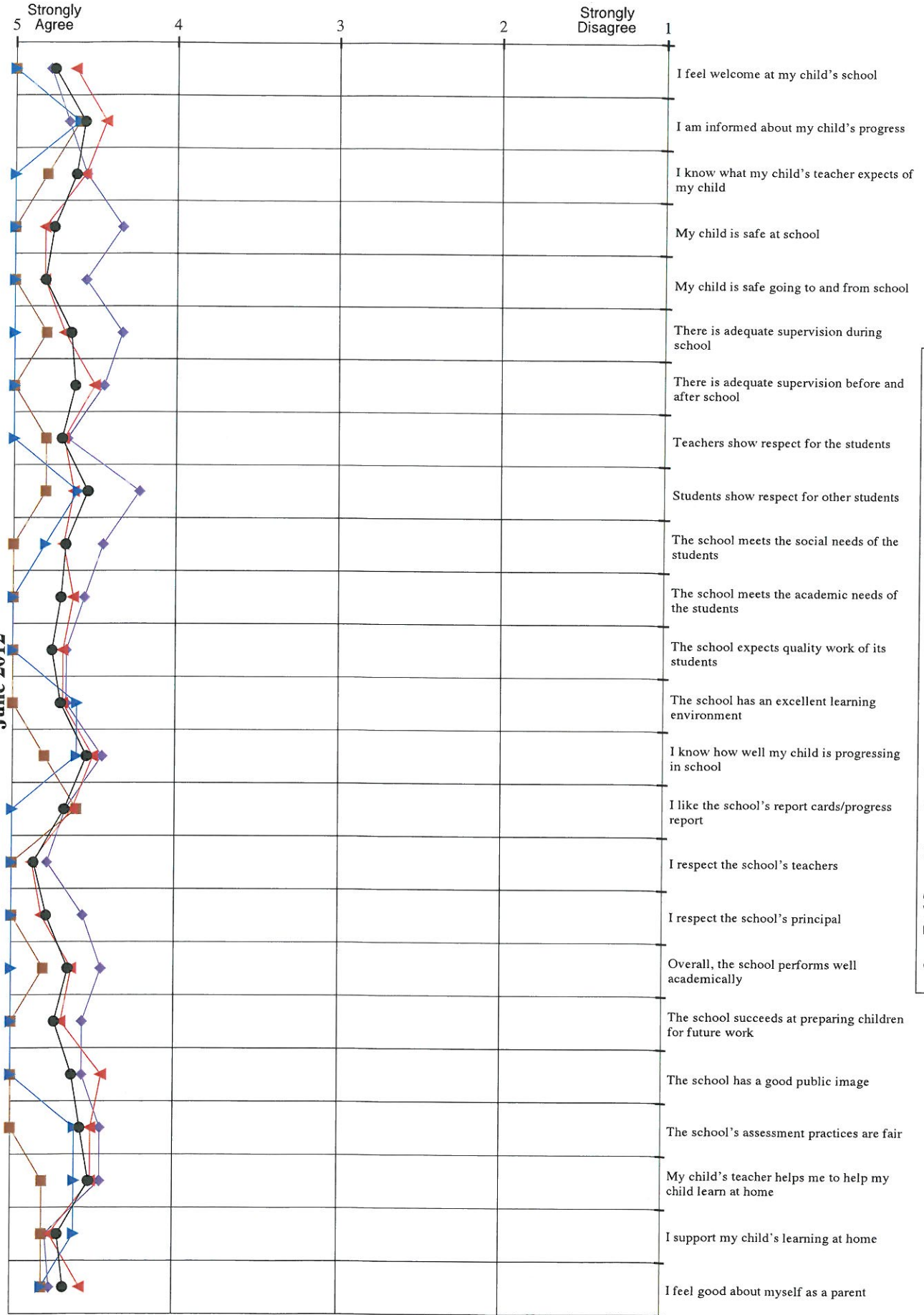






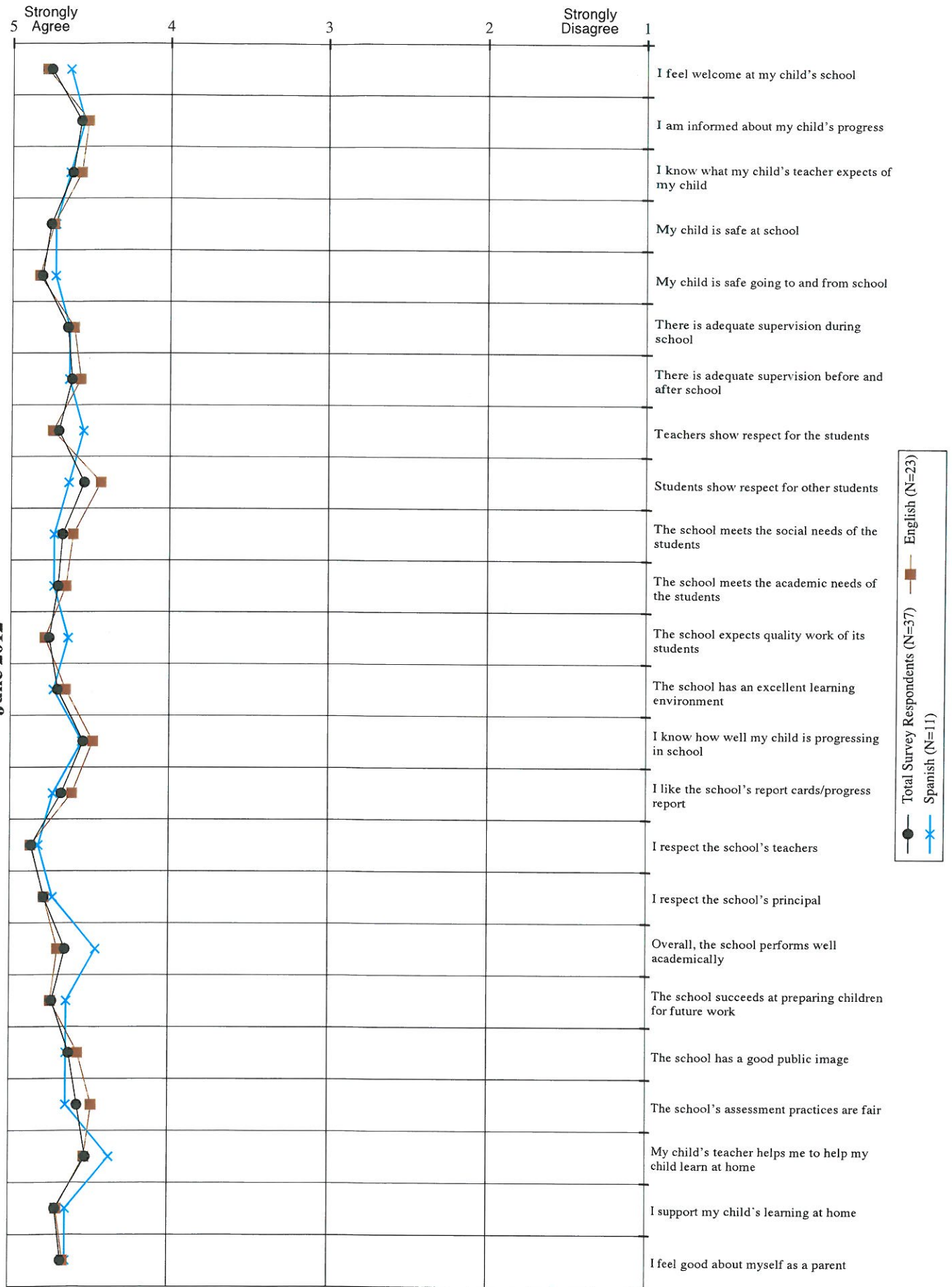
# Four Rivers Community School Parent Responses by Number of Children in Household

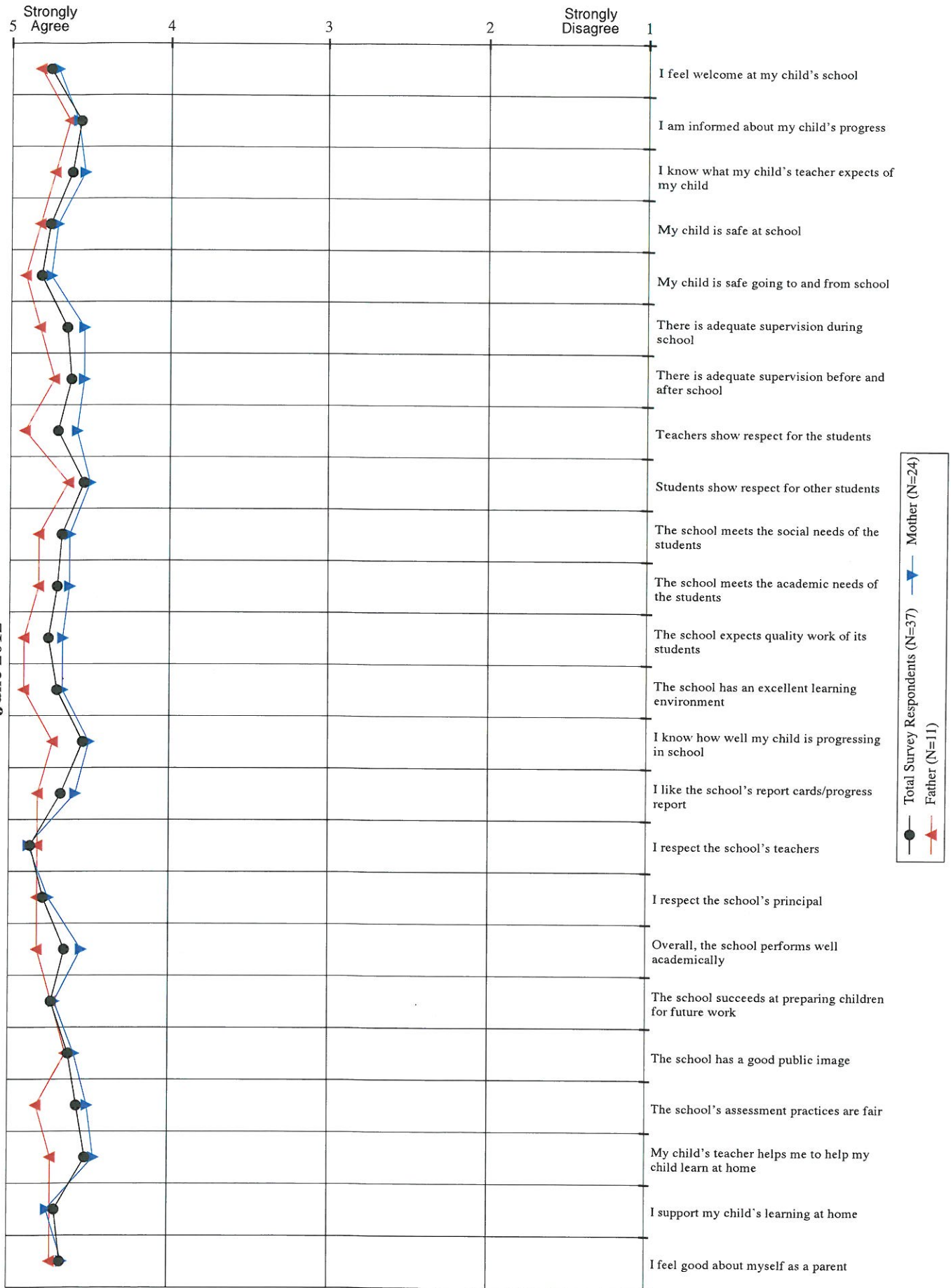

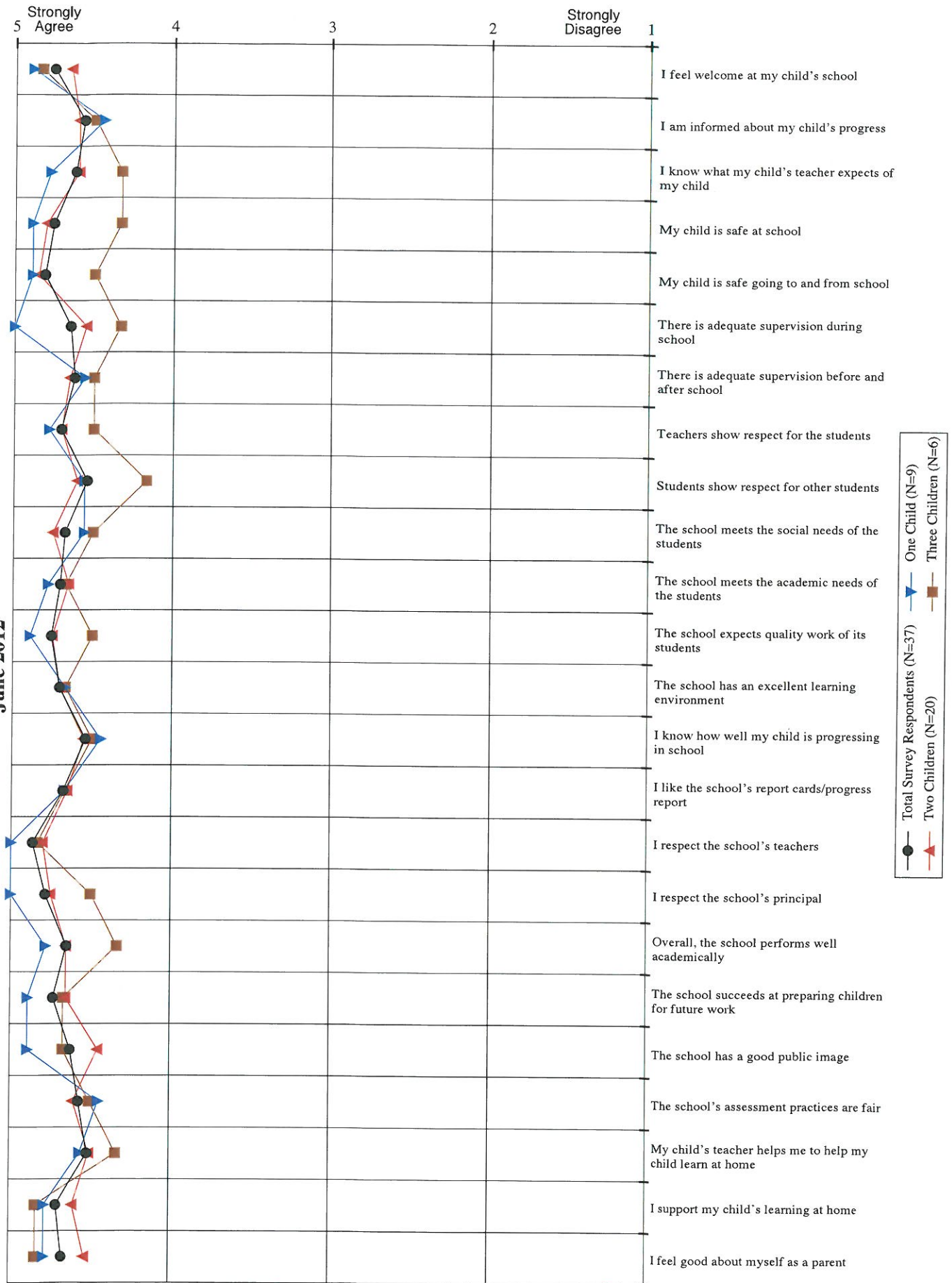
# Four Rivers Community School Parent Responses by Native Language June 2012
