ANNUAL MEASURABLE OBJECTIVES (AMOS) For 2015-16 through 2017-18

WHAT ARE ANNUAL MEASURABLE OBJECTIVES

Annual Measurable Objectives (AMOs) are targets set for student achievement in the subjects of English language arts and mathematics, as well as for graduation, attendance and participation. In 2011-12, Oregon's ESEA Flexibility Waiver revised the AMO targets for achievement and also changed the way they are used in school accountability. The Oregon Report Card provides a 5-level rating for each school. The overall rating for a school is a combination of the ratings received in each of the following five indicators:

- Achievement
- Growth
- Student Group Growth
- Graduation (high schools only)
- Student Group Graduation (high schools only)

AMO targets are incorporated into the Achievement, Graduation, and Student Group Graduation indicators, as described below. Please note that the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) did not assign overall school ratings to schools in 2015-16 due to the recent passage of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).

AMOs FOR ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS AND MATHEMATICS

Furthermore, the ODE retained the AMO targets from 2014-15 as the AMO targets for 2015-16 given the requirement to establish new targets and goals for the indicators that will be a part of the new school accountability system under ESSA. The AMO targets for 2015-16 represent the median school performance from the 2014-15 school year, and are used to set indicator levels for schools and student groups on the 2015-16 Report Card (RC) Rating Details Report. Schools and student groups meeting the targets below will receive a Level 4 or higher on the Achievement indicator.
