<b>Lead Organization</b>	<b>Echo SD 5</b>
<b>Goal #1</b>	Establish a 9-12 program that provides in person exposure to post secondary opportunities for those students in focus groups. This will be supported by a career and college coordinator and administration personally explaining advanced coursework and career opportunities in cohorts grades 6-12. A new tracker is being developed to support on time graduation, intervention notes, and monitoring career/college progress.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Each student identified in focus groups has at least two in person exposures to post secondary opportunities, trade schools, the trades, or job ready skills.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Students in focus groups are finding confidence and success in post secondary outcomes as displayed through increased attendance to colleges, community colleges, trades schools, and or direct employment.
<b>College Level Opportunities Activity #1</b>	A college/career coordinator will support the development of a tracker for OTRGRAD and career/college advanced coursework exposure grades 6-12. The administration will personally talks to all students 6-12 in cohorts several times throughout the year. In addition to developing a new data tracker, the school will continue to provide/expand advanced coursework exposure and tutoring opportunities.
