Lead Organization Falls City School District

Goal #1	100% of students will be on track for graduation at the end of their 9th grade year.
Short-Term Outcome	Ninth grade success teams (teachers and relevant support staff) are meeting regularly, looking at data, student supports are tracked for effectiveness and students and families are involved in the evaluation of those supports.
Long-Term Outcome	The overall 9th grade on-track rate of students will increase by 10%.
Goal #2	Beginning in 7th grade students will develop a plan to enter high school with a clear picture of their path to successful graduation and college and career readiness.
Short-Term Outcome	After various aptitude tests and interest inventories, teachers actively encourage students who are members of groups of students not typically engaged in advanced coursework or career and technical courses to pursue these paths in accord with their post-secondary plans, as expressed in the student's education plan and profile.
Long-Term Outcome	The student enrollment in advanced coursework will increase by 10%.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Continue 9th Grade on Track Class focused on strategies outlined in 9th Grade Success Network and other evidence-based strategies to provide 9th graders with tools for success in cooperation with families, staff and students.
