Goal #1	All students will be offered advanced coursework and/or CTE opportunities. either through manufacturing/business coursework or an education path. With a specific focus on our identified focal groups.
Short-Term Outcome	Manufacturing/business courses will be maintained and updated including a construction geometry course. Based on individual graduation plans, students (including those in identified focal groups) will be actively encouraged to pursue and successfully complete advanced coursework, CTE dual credit and/or the education path. Students involved in the education path will have the opportunity to work in the preschool lab or other classroom settings.
Long-Term Outcome	Funding for replacement and repair of CTE equipment will ensure sustainability for the program. Through extra counseling supports, increased numbers of students (including students from identified focal groups with a 10% increase in their population over the next 4 years) will enroll in advanced coursework and/or CTE dual credit coursework and be directed to appropriate post-secondary college/career training.
Goal #2	Students will leave 9th grade on-track for graduation through academic, attendance, behavior, and social supports.
Short-Term Outcome	9th grade on-track rates will improve with a full-time grad-coach, special education, and counseling staff meet regularly with teachers, pulling data (specific focus on identified focal groups), communicate with families, educating them on how to read a transcript, create grade plans, increasing parent contact/conferences, tracking who does not attend, individual outreach follows. Data will be tracked and student populations identified for those not attending. Interventions are created for students and evaluated for effectiveness. Students will have access to credit recovery through online courses and summer school opportunities.
Long-Term Outcome	On-time graduation rates will increase for all students (including those identified focal groups) with the implementation of on-track supports.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Summer School learning opportunities for credit recovery. The full-time guidance counselor will be hired 10 additional days to support credit recovery, graduation plans, and master schedule planning. Summer school teacher stipends and curriculum. Edmentum-Online credit recovery.

College Level Opportunities Activity #1	Provide HS students with the opportunity for college credit through AP Coursework, Willamette Promise, Northwest Promise, dual credit coursework or private institutions as needed and facilitate this process with staffing stipends.

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Career Technical Education Activity #1	Continuation of the preschool lab classroom will support the CTE education path. Students will have the opportunity to assist in the preschool throughout the day.
