Subcommittee Recommendations & Decision Making

- Training
 - Nathan Howard reporting
 - Significant amount of training outline includes all-hazards, focus on basic safety, communication, and situational awareness
 - Subcommittee is not equipped to make recommendation of who can/will provide training
 - Recommend that main committee decide what agency will conduct training
 - Suggestion to reach out to Legislature for guidance on who should provide training
 - Does Bill require us to set up training?
 - Bill intentionally does not say an agency needs to do lift on training, idea was to come to an agreement on what training should look like
- Credentialing
 - Harry Esteve reporting
 - Recommend that one agency updates and maintains list of those who have completed training, issues credentials, and revokes credentials if necessary
 - What agency?
 - SPJ willing to maintain spreadsheet of credentialed media
 - Do we need hold harmless agreement?
 - Recommend one central webpage, possibly on OEM website, with all information about Bill and information on training
- PPE
 - April Ehrlich reporting
 - Recommending all-hazards core set of gear, required to access any disaster zone
 - Building recommendation specifically for wildfire, depending on what part of fire scene they want to access

Next Steps

- Admin Subcommittee – Develop SOGs (1 document geared towards media, 1 document geared towards incident commanders and field personnel)
 - Review Bill, ensure SOGs address requirements
 - Final draft of SOGs to committee for review and approval

- Admin committee get rough draft together by 11/23
- Possible request for report/update for Legislature in December
- Schedule meeting with agency stakeholders – awareness of possible inclusion in providing training or credentialing
 - Schedule after admin subcommittee has SOGs drafted – Week of Dec 12
- Next committee meeting week of Dec 12
