

OREGON RECREATIONAL BOATING ACCIDENT STATISTICS - 1982

The following statistics were extracted from boating accident reports received by the Oregon State Marine Board for 1982 calendar year.

Comments on the year...

1980-1982 were the three best consecutive years for boating fatalities in Oregon.

In 1982, the majority of fatal accidents involved the following:

- Male victim, over 50 years of age
- Small craft, less than 14' in length
- Capsizing or fall overboard, probably due to action of passenger
- No PFD worn, 19 of the 20 victims
- Cold water, less than 60°
- No help nearby. In fact, there were no survivors or witness to just about half of the fatal accidents.

Note: 1982 was an unusual year for two reasons:

- 1. Most fatal accidents took place on lakes, whereas the majority usually occurs on rivers.
- 2. Most happened to operators over 50 years of age. More typically the 26-50 age range.
