

OREGON RECREATIONAL BOATING ACCIDENT STATISTICS – 1986

The following statistics were extracted from boating accident reports received by the Oregon State Marine Board for 1986 calendar year.

Comments on the year...

In 1986, 18 people died in recreational boating accidents. This figure represents the lowest number of boating deaths in a year since 1973 when 17 people died.

Seven people were killed in coastal boating accidents, which is more than we usually lose.

On a more positive note, only two people died in canoeing/rafting accidents. In an average year we lose between six and ten boaters in canoes and rafts.

Of the 18 fatalities, only four bodies were tested for alcohol content. Most victims were not tested because their bodies were never recovered or their bodies were in the water too long to get an accurate reading of alcohol content. The four who were tested showed no signs of alcohol.

Alcohol was involved in at least five of the accidents according to witness statements
