# Utility Actions In Response to Forecast Extreme Weather

### Evaluating risks

- Forecasts
- Resource Assessment
- Coordination with Affected Communities
- What situational awareness regarding the magnitude of damage

### Identifying Operations

- Resourcing Plans
  - Coordination with contractors
  - Coordination with public safety partners
  - Coordination with other utilities
  - Any mutual assistance requests
  - Support for warming shelters if priority restoration was required
  - Support opportunities for ESF-12 or -2

### Recovery

- Crews deployed
- Damage experienced (how did it compare to forecasts)?
- Restoration curves
- Complications to restoration...access, safety, etc.
- SNAP data support for benefit replacement
- After action learnings
