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8 Clay Haynes has applied to sit for the Supervising Electrician’s license. The Electrical and Elevator
9 Board (Electrical Board) of the State of Oregon, based on previous actions taken by the Board
10 against your license, wish to enter into a consent agreement regarding your application to sit for the
11 examination.

12 You agree to conduct all future business in compliance with the applicable statutes, administrative
13 rules, and specialty codes. As evidenced by the authorized signatures on this Order, you hereby
14 consent to the entry of this Order and its following terms.

15 **FINDINGS OF FACT and CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 16 (1) On or about February 22, 2013 you applied to take the General Supervising
17 Electrician’s examination.
- 18 (2) On July 29, 2013, you paid to the Division’s fiscal section \$790.50 for penalties
19 assessed.
- 20 (3) As of the payment made on July 29, 2013 you have no further outstanding civil
21 penalties due and owing.

22 **STIPULATED AGREEMENT**

23 You and the Board agree to the following terms:

- 24 1. The Board hereby accepts, through the Building Codes Division staff, your application to sit for
25 the General Supervising Electrician’s examination.
2. If you pass the examination, you agree not to commit further violations of the Building Code
Division’s statutes or rules.
3. You understand that if you pass the examination your license will be conditioned for three years
upon no violations of the division’s statutes and rules relating to a supervising electrician’s duty
to ensure only properly licensed individuals conduct electrical installations.

- 1 4. You understand that if the Division finds you have violated the supervising electrician's duty to
2 ensure only properly licensed individuals conduct electrical installations or if the Division finds
two or more permitting violations your supervising license will be immediately revoked.
- 3 5. You understand and agree that any violation of the Building Code Division's statutes or rules
4 not alleged in this Order, committed after the execution of this Consent Order, may be the basis
for further enforcement action.
- 5 6. Your license may be renewed without condition in three years during the regular renewal
6 period, provided you comply with the terms of this Agreement and have not committed any
further violations of Building Code Division's statutes and rules.
- 7 7. You understand that the Division may periodically require documentation from you
8 demonstrating compliance with the Division's statutes and rules.
- 9 8. You have read and fully understand the terms of this Consent Order, freely and voluntarily
10 consent to the entry of this Order without further hearing, without any force or duress, and
expressly waive all rights to hearing or appeal in this matter.
- 11 9. You understand once this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order becomes a FINAL ORDER
12 it becomes a public document.
- 13 10. You further agree by signing this Settlement Agreement and Consent Order that you are the
14 respondent and/or authorized representative for the respondent in this matter.
