## WHAT THE LAW SAYS

(1) Under ORS 479.550(1), except as provided in ORS 479.540, no person shall work on any new electrical installation for which a permit has not been issued.

(2) Under OAR 918-282-0120(1), no person or entity shall allow any individual to perform electrical work for which the individual is not properly registered or licensed.

## STIPULATED AGREEMENT

Respondent and the Board agrees to resolve this matter, without a hearing, with the entry of this Consent Order subject to the following terms and conditions:

(1) The Board hereby assesses a civil penalty against you of \$3,000 for violating ORS 479.550(1) and OAR 918-282-0120(1), but suspends \$1,500 of the civil penalty assessed for a period of five years under the following terms:

(1.1) Respondent agrees to pay the remaining \$1,500 of the civil penalty.

**(1.2) If Respondent is able to submit a full payment of \$1,000 by the invoice due date, an additional \$500 will be suspended. The invoice will be included with your copy of the Final Order after it is signed by the Board.**

(2) Respondent agrees if a final order is issued by the Board finding Respondent violated any of Building Codes Division's statutes or rules, within five years from the date this Order was signed by the Board, Respondent will pay any subsequent penalty and the suspended penalty from this Order.

(3) Respondent agrees not to commit further violations of Building Codes Division's statutes or rules.

(4) Respondent understands that if the respondent fails to comply with any of the terms of this consent agreement that the entire civil penalty, including the amount suspended, will be immediately due and payable. Failure to comply includes failure to pay the civil penalty amount on the Final Demand Notice by the due date, or failure to make payments according to the terms of any payment arrangement or Final Demand Notice.

(5) Respondent understands and agrees any violation of the terms of this Consent Order will result in further enforcement action.

(6) Respondent understands and agrees that any violations of Building Code Division's statutes or rules not alleged in this Order, whether committed before or after the execution of this Consent Order, shall be the basis for further enforcement action.



5 or rules.

6 (8) Respondent has read and fully understands the terms of this Consent Order,  
7 freely and voluntarily consents to the entry of this Order without further hearing, without  
8 any force or duress, and expressly waives all rights to a hearing or appeal in this matter.

9 (9) Respondent understands that, upon signature of all parties, this Consent  
10 Order will be a FINAL ORDER.


11 (10) Respondent further agrees by signing this Consent Order that Respondent is
