7 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 8 1. Respondent holds a journeyman electrician's license, no. 21968J. The license expired on
9 October 1, 2012.
- 10 2. On at least three occasions since April 2011, Respondent's journeyman electrician's license
11 has been suspended at the request of the Oregon Department of Justice/Child Support
12 Division, or municipal court acting on behalf of the Oregon Department of Justice/Child
13 Support Division, for nonpayment of child support.¹
- 14 3. Respondent wishes to renew his journeyman electrician's license.

15 **STIPULATED ORDER**

16 Upon payment of the appropriate fees, the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business
17 Services (Director) will renew Respondent's journeyman electrician's license under the following
18 conditions:

- 19 1. Respondent understands his journeyman electrician's license, no. 21968J, will be revoked
20 for a period of five years if it is determined he performs work requiring an active
21 journeyman electrician's while his license is suspended upon a future request from the
22 Oregon Department of Justice/Child Support Division, or municipal court acting on behalf
23 of the Oregon Department of Justice/Child Support Division. Such revocation action will be
24 taken following the opportunity for a hearing and an issuance of a final order finding
25 Respondent performed an electrical installation while not validly licensed.
- 1 2. Respondent agrees to cooperate fully with relevant Division investigations. Cooperation
2 includes, but is not limited to, providing all information requested by the Director including
3 invoices, work orders etc., and answering all questions fully and truthfully during any
4 investigation or contested case process. Failure to cooperate fully will result in revocation of
5 his journeyman license no. 21968J, without opportunity for a hearing, for a period of five
6 years.
- 7 3. Respondent understands that following the Division's investigation into previous work
8 performed by Respondent, should the Division determine Respondent did not fully disclose
9 each and every location he has performed work without a valid license during the time



1 period in question, Respondent's journeyman electrician's license, no. 21968J, will be
2 revoked for a period of five years without opportunity for a hearing. Such revocation action
3 will be taken following the opportunity for a hearing and an issuance of a final order finding
4 Respondent performed an electrical installation while not validly licensed.

- 5 4. Respondent agrees to pay any and all future civil penalties in a timely manner. Failure to pay
6 any future civil penalties in a timely manner will result in revocation of his journeyman
7 license no. 21968J for a period of five years.
- 8 5. Respondent has read and understands the terms of this stipulated order, freely and
9 voluntarily, without any force or duress, consents to the entry of this order and expressly
10 waives all rights to a hearing, appeal, or judicial review in this matter. Respondent
11 understands this stipulated agreement does not prevent the Director or any advisory board
12 from pursuing any other sanction associated with any violation of Oregon Specialty Codes
13 committed by Respondent.

14 It is so stipulated.
