8 Under ORS 455.895(1)(a) and (b), and OAR 918-001-0036, the State Plumbing Board
9 (Board) proposes disciplinary action against Respondent in the form of civil penalties, totaling
10 \$2,000, for violations of Building Codes Division statutes and rules as follows:

11 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

12 Respondent installed potable water piping at 1621 SE McBrod Street, Milwaukie,
13 Oregon, without a valid journeyman plumber license, in violation of ORS 693.030(1).

14 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

15 Installing potable water piping is a plumbing installation as defined in ORS 447.010(6).

16 **WHAT THE LAW SAYS**

17 Under ORS 693.030(1), a person may not engage in the trade of journeyman plumber
18 without a journeyman plumber license.

19 **ORDER**

20 Under ORS 455.895(1)(a) and OAR 918-001-0036, the State Plumbing Board assesses
21 the following:

22 (1) a \$2,000 civil penalty for violating ORS 693.030(1).



NOTICE OF FINAL ORDER

If Respondent does not request a hearing within 20 days, withdraws a hearing request, notifies the Director or the administrative law judge that they will not appear, or fails to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Director will issue a Final Order by Default. If the Director issues a Final Order by Default, it designates the file, including any materials submitted by Respondent that relate to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a prima facie case.

Respondent is entitled to judicial review of any final order issued in the matter of this Notice of a Proposed Civil Penalty. Judicial review may be obtained by filing a petition for review with the Oregon Court of Appeals within 60 days after the Final Order is served. See ORS 183.482. If the Order was served in person, the service date is the date Respondent received the Order. If the Order was served through the mail, the service date is the day the Order was mailed, not the day it was received by Respondent. If Respondent does not file a petition for judicial review within 60 days, Respondent will lose the right to appeal. The phone number for the Oregon Court of Appeals is 503-986-5555.
