3 plumber without a journeyman plumber license issued under this chapter.
- 4 3. Under OAR 918-785-0200(1)(a), no person, firm, or corporation shall do
5 plumbing work in the State of Oregon without first obtaining a plumbing permit.

6 **ORDER**

7 Under ORS 455.895(1)(a) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Board assesses the
8 following sanctions:

- 9 (1) \$3,000 civil penalty for violating ORS 447.040(1)
10 (2) \$2,000 civil penalty for violating ORS 693.030(1)
11 (3) \$1,000 civil penalty for violating OAR 918-785-0200(1)(a)

12 Civil penalties assessed total \$6,000.

13 **NOTICE OF RIGHT TO HEARING**

14 You are entitled to a hearing as provided by the Administrative Procedures Act, Oregon
15 Revised Statutes, Chapter 183. If you request a hearing, the request must be in writing
16 and filed with the Division no later than 20 days from the service date. If this Notice was
17 served to you in person, the service date is the date you received this Notice. If this
18 Notice was served through the mail, the service date is the day the Notice was mailed,
19 not the day you received it.

20 If a request for hearing is not received within 20 days, your right to a hearing is
21 considered waived unless the failure to request a hearing was beyond your reasonable
22 control. Mail hearing requests to Building Codes Division, Enforcement Section, P.O.
23 Box 14470, Salem, Oregon, 97309.

24 You have the right to be represented by legal counsel. ORS 183.457 provides that a
25 corporation may be represented by an authorized representative at the hearing. If you
request a hearing, you will be notified of the time and place of the hearing and be given
information on procedures, right of representation, and other rights of parties relating to
the hearing before it begins.

¹ OAR 918-030-0010(8) For purposes of ORS 447.040, 479.620, 480.630 and any other license regulated by ORS
chapter 455, "engaging in the business" means to advertise or solicit, contract or agree to perform, or to perform,
work for which a license or permit is required under Oregon law, including but not limited to a single instance.
