INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 675.540, the
above-entitled matter came before the State Board of Clinical
Social Workers (Board), on Complaint involving ~~VB~~ and
~~SD~~ (clients)

Pursuant to ORS 183.415(5) and Oregon Administrative Rules
(OAR) 877-40-045, in order to informally dispose of and settle
this matter, Carol J. Doster (Doster) and the Board, by and
through its Chair, Carol Ormiston, make the following
statements.

Doster admits and stipulates that she has been advised of
her rights to request a hearing in this matter pursuant to ORS
183.415(2)(a) and to be represented by an attorney at a hearing
pursuant to ORS 183.415(3).

Doster waives her rights to request a hearing in this matter
and to be represented by an attorney at a hearing.

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1 STIPULATION (IN THE MATTER OF THE LICENSE OF CAROL DOSTER)

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1 STIPULATION

2 I.

3 The Board and Doster stipulate and agree that Doster may be
4 disciplined under the provisions of ORS 675.540(2)(b) in that,
5 without admitting the truth of the factual basis supporting the
6 Board's findings, Doster agrees that, if true, the factual basis
7 relied on by the Board would support a finding that Doster has
8 violated one or more of the rules of the Board, specifically OAR
9 877-30-005(2)(d) and (4) by the following alleged actions not
10 admitted, but not contested by Doster:

11 (a) Doster entered into client provider contracts with
12 ^{VB} [REDACTED] and ^{SD} [REDACTED]. During the course of Doster's
13 clinical relationship with ^{VB} [REDACTED] she became very close friends
14 with ^{VB} [REDACTED]. This friendship was evidenced by cards sent to
15 ^{VB} [REDACTED] and by social contacts with ^{VB} [REDACTED]. These actions
16 constitute a dual relationship with a client which increased the
17 risk of client exploitation in violation of OAR 877-30-005(2)(d).

18 (b) During the course of the clinical relationship with
19 both ^{VB} [REDACTED] and ^{SD} [REDACTED], Doster told each of them information
20 that the other had revealed in the course of the clinical
21 relationship. This constitutes a breach of the confidential
22 relationship between client and therapist in violation of ORS
23 675.580(1) and OAR 877-30-005(4).

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II.

The Board and Doster stipulate and agree that this disciplinary action may be concluded by entry of this Stipulation on the following terms:

- (a) Doster shall undergo supervision by ~~an LCSW~~ ^{an LCSW} for at least two years. This supervision shall specifically address client-related ethics issues and dual relationships. For the first year, the supervision shall occur at least twice a month and for at least one hour each session, for a minimum of 40 hours per year unless both the supervisor and the Board agree that less supervision is appropriate. This supervision shall include direct evaluation of Doster's cases by audio, video or one-way mirror. All such supervision shall be at the sole cost of Doster.
- (b) The frequency and amount of supervision for the second year will be at the discretion of the supervisor.
- (c) The supervisor shall provide a formal report to the Board every six months and at the end of the second year.
- (d) Doster shall attend therapy sessions with a Mental Health Professional licensed by the State of Oregon and recommended by the supervisor and approved by Doster, if the supervisor believes such therapy to be necessary. The supervisor shall, in consultation with the Mental Health Professional, decide on the frequency of such therapy, which shall be at the sole cost of Doster.
- (e) Doster consents to the supervisor or Mental Health Professional contacting the Board if the supervisor or Mental Health Professional believes there is a risk to the public by the continued practice as an LCSW of Doster.
- (f) Doster consents to the supervisor and therapist consulting regarding Doster's progress as necessary.
- (g) At the end of the second year of supervision the supervisor shall, as part of the fourth formal report required by Section (c) above, provide a letter to the
