**STIPULATED ORDER OF REPRIMAND
FOR ADDITIONAL CONTINUING
EDUCATION AND ASSESSMENT OF
COSTS**

Case No. 2004-19

1.

The Board of Clinical Social Workers (Board) is the agency responsible for licensing, regulating, and disciplining Licensed Clinical Social Workers in the State of Oregon.

2.

At all times material herein, Kathleen Boeve, LCSW, (Licensee) was a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in Oregon and subject to the jurisdiction of the Board.

3.

Licensee provided clinical social work services within the meaning of ORS 675.510(2) to Client JA during the periods of January, 1986 to October, 1990 (approximately 113 sessions), January, 1998 to July, 1998, (approximately 13 sessions), and May, 2002, to May, 2003 (approximately 46 sessions). Licensee entered into an office rental agreement with Client JA starting in January, 2000, that allowed Client JA to use part of Licensee's office space for a maximum of 10 hours per week to provide therapeutic massages to clients of Client JA. Client JA paid Licensee a fixed rate per month to use Licensee's office space. Licensee and Client JA had this rental arrangement from January, 2000, to September, 2001.

4.

Licensee provided clinical social work services within the meaning of ORS 675.510(2) to Client DE during the periods of January, 1993, to December, 1993, (approximately 37 sessions), July, 2000 (1 session), December, 2000 (1 session), April, 2002 (1 session), and April, 2004 (1 session). Client DE provided part-time (between 15-20 hours per week) contracted office support for Licensee, beginning in June, 1995, through and until in March, 2004. Client DE provided insurance billing services to Licensee part-time (approximately 5 hours per week) for a six month period beginning in May, 2004. Licensee paid Client DE at a fixed rate twice a month for the services provided.

5.

Licensee provided clinical social work services within the meaning of ORS 675.510(2) to Client DI during the periods of November, 1999, to July, 2001 (75 sessions), January, 2002 to October, 2002, (56 sessions) and March, 2004 to July, 2004 (9 sessions). Client DI provided janitorial services to Licensee three times in November, 2003, for a fixed rate.

6.

Based on the foregoing, Licensee entered into non-therapeutic relationships with Clients JA, DE, and DI that had the potential for exercising undue influence on said clients, in violation of OAR 877-030-0070(3).

7.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by entry of this Stipulated Order of Reprimand and for Additional Continuing Education (Stipulated Order) in full and final settlement of this matter, pursuant to ORS 183.415(5).

8.

The Board shall issue a letter of reprimand to Licensee for the above conduct and violations within thirty (30) days of issuance of this Stipulated Order, pursuant to ORS 675.595(4).

9.

Licensee must complete an additional ten (10) hours of Continuing Education Units focused on dual relationship and client boundary issues within one year of issuance of this Stipulated Order, pursuant to ORS 675.595(6). These specific Continuing Education hours are in addition to the normal Continuing Education requirements for Licensee to maintain her clinical social worker license. These Continuing Education hours must be approved in advance by the Board. Licensee must provide a detailed report to the Board on the completion of this Continuing Education requirement, including what Licensee learned from this additional continuing education and how Licensee intends to integrate that information into her clinical social work practice, within the one year period. All costs, fees, and expenses required for Licensee to complete this additional Continuing Education requirement and provide the detailed report to the Board must be paid for entirely by Licensee.

10.

Licensee is assessed and shall pay the Board's costs of this disciplinary process in the sum of \$450.80 to date, pursuant to ORS 675.595(17). Licensee must pay this sum to the Board within thirty (30) days of issuance of this Stipulated Order and failure to do so shall be grounds for revocation, pursuant to ORS 675.595(3).

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11.

Licensee acknowledges and understands the following:

11.1. This Stipulated Order will be submitted to the Board for approval and is subject to and conditioned upon approval by the full Board. This Stipulated Order, once issued by the Board, is a final order;

11.2. This Stipulated Order is a public document and a matter of public discipline. This document must be disclosed, published, and reported in accordance with ORS 676.175(3)(a)(D), OAR 877-040-0050(6), and Oregon Public Records Law;

11.3. Licensee has been fully advised of her rights to notice and a contested case hearing under the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS Chapter 183), and fully and finally waives all such rights and any rights to appeal or otherwise challenge this Stipulated Order; and

11.4. Licensee has fully read this Stipulated Order and understands it completely. Licensee voluntarily, without any force or duress, consents to issuance and entry of this Stipulated Order. Licensee states that no promises or representation has been made to induce Licensee to sign this Stipulated Order. Licensee has consulted with an attorney regarding this Stipulated Order and has been fully advised in regards thereto or waives any and all rights to consult with an attorney prior to issuance and entry of this Stipulated Order.
