STIPULATED AGREEMENT ORDER

The Board of Clinical Social Workers (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing and disciplining clinical social workers, and for regulating the practice of clinical social work in the State of Oregon. Charles Jeff Manley, LCSW (Licensee) was licensed by the Board to practice as a clinical social worker in Oregon on or about April 2, 1999.

1.

On July 6, 1999, the Board served Licensee with a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Notice) and notified Licensee that it intended to place Licensee on a one-year suspension and assess a civil penalty of \$1,000 for unprofessional conduct with a client, based on two violations of law.

2.

On September 3, 1999, Licensee, by and through his then attorney, David G. Terry, filed a written Answer denying, in substance, the allegations contained in the Notice. A copy of Licensee's Answer is marked Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.



On or about May 15, 2000, Licensee retained attorney Kevin T. Lafky to represent him in the pending Notice.

4.

Licensee's license to practice as social work in the State of Oregon was not renewed and lapsed on or about March 31, 2000.

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5.

On June 7, 2000, attorney for Licensee, Kevin Lafky, indicated that Licensee would be interested in a negotiated settlement of the Notice.

6.

The Board and Licensee, hereby stipulate and agree that they are willing to informally dispose of and settle this matter without a contested case hearing. This stipulation sets forth the terms of the order that the Licensee agrees may be issued by the Board:

6.1 A Letter of ^{Reprimand CB 7/05} Remand is accepted by Licensee stating:

“Charles Manley was formerly licensed as a clinical social worker by the Oregon Board of Clinical Social Workers (Board). In April of 1999 Douglas County Health and Social Services Department employed him. On April 2, 1999, Mr. Manley acted contrary to the Douglas County Health & Social Services Department Policy and Procedures in dealing with a Department client or visitor by failing to act in ways that may have been designed to stop emotional distress from escalating into aggressive behavior. As a result of Mr. Manley’s behavior, he engaged in unprofessional conduct under ORS 675.540(1)(d). In accepting the Reprimand, Mr. Manley is not admitting to the conduct that underlies the Board’s conclusion of unprofessional conduct under ORS 675.540(1)(d), but Mr. Manley understands that the Board will publish this disciplinary action under the provisions of OAR 877-040-0050(6).”

FINAL ORDER

The Board issues the following order:

1. Licensee waives all rights to have a hearing, rehearing, appeal or judicial review relating to this Stipulated Final Order.
2. Licensee violated ORS 675.540(1)(d).
3. All investigative materials prepared or received by the Board concerning these violations and all related notices and pleadings will be retained in the Board’s file concerning this matter.
