Limited Residential Electrician Apprenticeship Applications

LIMITED RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION ELECTRICIAN APPRENTICESHIP OPENINGS

The NECA-IBEW Electrical JATC (MA#1004) will accept applications on the following dates:

Applicants are encouraged to attend orientation prior to applying

NECA-IBEW Electrical Training Trust admits students of any race, color and national or ethnic origin.

REQUIRED AT TIME OF APPLICATION:

- Photo identification
- Copy of: High School Diploma or GED Certificate
- Transcripts for Math Requirement – See Minimum Requirements

MINIMUM PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- At least 18 years of age - proof of age may be required.
 - Documentation of successful completion of one full year of high school mathematics (Transcript Required)
 - **OR** Equivalent placement test score from a community college or other educational facility indicating a placement level beyond high school level math – Transcript required at time of application
 - **OR** documentation of successful completion of online NJATC math course @ www.njatc.org

APPLICATION TIMELINE:

All application documents received by the last Wednesday of the month will be processed as a group using the following timeline:

1. Training Center will notify applicant by mail if they qualify or non-qualify. If application qualifies, applicant will be notified of date and time for interview. (example: qualified February applicants will interview in March). If application does not qualify, letter will be sent stating the non-qualifying reason and the application will be closed.
2. Final ranking of new applicants will occur after the interview is held. (example: candidates interviewed in March will be placed on the ranked list in March).

IF ACCEPTED: Employer requires substance abuse test and background check.

The NECA-IBEW Electrical JATC offers a 2 1/2-year (as of June 1, 2008) Limited Residential Construction apprenticeship program that combines both on the job and related classroom training. Oregon-Columbia Chapter NECA and IBEW Local 48 sponsor this program.

If accepted into the apprentice program you will work for an electrical contractor for a minimum of 4000 OJT hours; there is no guarantee of 40 hours per week. You will complete a total of 5 terms of school; classes currently meet at the NECA-IBEW Electrical Training Center.

A general description of work performed on the job includes the following categories:

- Wiring of outlets in single & multiple family residences
- Wiring services, meters and distribution
- Wiring and servicing appliances
- Remodeling of residential buildings
- Installation of music, intercom systems and antennas
- Wiring and servicing electric heat systems
- Wiring and servicing air conditioning systems

Apprentice wages are based on a percentage of the current prevailing Limited Residential Construction Journeyman rate (\$26.00 per hour effective 1-1-2011) in addition to benefits.

Apprentices are advanced to the next period only when all advancement requirements have been met. Upon completion of all program requirements apprentices are referred to take the Limited Residential Journeyman exam.

Geographical area covered: Clatsop, Clackamas, Columbia, Hood River, Multnomah, Sherman, Tillamook, Wasco, Washington Counties, Yamhill County North of section line T4S, State of Oregon. Clark, Klickitat and Skamania Counties, Washington.
