DESCRIPTION OF WORK

HVAC/R (Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration) combines sheet metal and electrical work involving installation, wiring, service, and repair of environmental control systems and the fabrication and installation of ductwork.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Work is done indoors and outdoors. Work spaces can range from outdoor scaffolding to crawl spaces inside a wall.

GEOGRAPHICAL AREA

Employers who participate in this program are located in Marion, Polk, Linn, Benton, and South one-half of Yamhill counties.
