**REGARDING:** Proposed Rulemaking regarding implementation of new minimum wage.

On April 15, 2016, the Bureau filed with the Oregon Secretary of State a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking regarding proposed amending of rules to implement senate bill 1532, adopted by the Oregon legislature during the 2016 session. The filing amends the Rulemaking Hearing notice filed on March 14. That hearing will be on April 25, 2016 at 2pm in room 1B in the Portland State Office Building, 800 NE Oregon St., Portland, OR 97232.

With this memo please find the Notices of Proposed Rulemaking and the Statements of Need and Fiscal Impact. The rulemaking will be focused on defining employer location and other updates identified.
