Need for the Rule(s): The proposed amendments conform outdated procedural rules of the Wage and Hour Commission to those of the Bureau of Labor and Industries and implement legislation enacted in 2007 authorizing the commission to enforce its investigative subpoenas in state court. The new rules proposed provide subpoena procedures and accountability as required by the legislation.


