

## Prevailing Wage Advisory Committee Members Sought

The purpose of the legislatively established Prevailing Wage Advisory Committee (PWAC) is to assist the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries in the administration of the Prevailing Wage Rate Law. (ORS 279C.820)

The PWAC is required to include equal representation of members from management and labor in the building and construction industry who perform work on public works contracts. The commissioner may also appoint other interested parties to the committee.

There are currently three vacancies on the PWAC; two “management” seats, and one “labor” seat.

Commissioner Avakian is seeking expressions of interest from interested persons in serving on the PWAC.
