Bob Bussel has been an associate professor of history and director of the Labor Education and Research Center at the University of Oregon since 2002. Prior to coming to Oregon, he taught in the labor education program at Penn State University for seven years.

Before entering the university labor education field, Professor Bussel worked for ten years for the Amalgamated Clothing and Textile Workers Union. He holds a masters degree in labor education from Rutgers University and a Ph.D. in history from Cornell University. His first book, *From Harvard to the Ranks of Labor: Powers Hapgood and the American Working Class*, was published in 1999.

He has also published numerous articles on labor history and contemporary labor issues that have appeared in academic and popular publications. Professor Bussel is currently editing a University of Oregon report on the immigrant experience that will be published in the spring of 2008.
