Welcome to the website of the Oregon Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision. Since 1911, the Board has been an active part of our state's public safety team. Today, the Board's work is reflected in our mission statement:

“To protect the public and reduce the risk of repeat criminal behavior through incarceration and community supervision decisions based on applicable laws, victims' interests, public safety, and recognized principles of offender behavior change.”

Currently, there are approximately 14,000 offenders under the Board's authority. In order to meet those broad mission-based goals (which are also embodied in the Constitution, state law, and administrative rule) the Board holds approximately 200 face-face-hearings per year with inmates and issues over 400 warrants, orders, and sanctions per month. The Board's staff also works to timely notify the 6,000+ registered victims of upcoming hearings or other important information related to their individual case.

A critical focus of our mission is to keep the public informed. We hope you will use this website to learn about Board procedures, dates of upcoming hearings, meetings, or results of pending hearings.
