**Governor Appoints De Wolf and Stern to
Construction Contractors Board**

Governor Ted Kulongoski has appointed Portland area contractor Richard De Wolf and Yamhill County Commissioner Mary Stern to the Oregon Construction Contractors Board (CCB). De Wolf will serve as a representative from the residential/small commercial remodeling industry and Stern will serve as the elected official representative.

De Wolf is the owner of Arciform LLC—a design-build company specializing in the restoration and remodel of historic and vintage pre-World War II homes in Portland and its suburbs.

Stern has served as a Yamhill County Commissioner for four years and is beginning her second term in office.

“2007 will likely be a historic year as it relates to how Oregon chooses to regulate construction contractors and offer protections for consumers,” says Craig P. Smith, Administrator for the CCB. “De Wolf and Stern will be great assets to the board during this time.”

The nine-member board is appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Oregon State Senate. Members include two public members, one elected official and six contractors. The board sets policy and hears claims appeal cases.

The CCB is a state agency licensing more than 43,000 contractors. Anyone who is paid to repair, improve or build a home must be licensed by the CCB. Consumers can verify a contractor's license and find information for successful projects at www.oregon.gov/CCB or by calling 503-378-4621.
