

Access And Outreach Meeting Minutes July 10, 2012

Recruitment- Recruitment for committee going well. Several interested partners added to the roster sheet. Some will regularly attend; others will attend as able. Call-in option helpful for those in outlying areas.

TQRIS- Summer Happenings- Lisa shared a PowerPoint presentation on TQRIS, sharing Oregon's vision, components, model, as well as information on where CCD has traveled this spring, talking with 225 providers/center staff and partners. There was a good deal of conversation around the supports and incentives that are a part of the model and what focus groups thought were examples and ideas of both supports and incentives. (PowerPoint attached). Lisa concluded presentation by talking about next steps, which include a cost modeling exercise in July, finalizing materials and rolling out a field test in January, 2013. Oregon Training Data- Ingrid shared a demo of the training calendar so group could see what actually happens as a whole (offered training sessions and number of participants that attended- by conference setting or local CCR&R, location, whether training was distance ed., hybrid, or classroom).

Next year's data should be more accurate, clean. We will be able to see where there is duplication, where there are gaps.

This will be useful in assisting Access & Outreach committee with work plan. We can receive itemization of what we would like to know (ex: how many attended a training session, what was the core knowledge category, by sda, by language, etc). This will assist with collecting data. Where are the bumps?

Registered Family Overview- Lisa shared that there is a scheduled meeting coming up to discuss re-vamping the Registered Family Child Care Overview as it is needed and is timely with rule revision taking place.

Bev- Words of Wisdom- Bev is retiring the end of August and will start her retirement off with a trip out of the country with her sister. Bev was pondering about the way decisions are made in Oregon. So much is done by committee work and although there isn't always 100% agreement, often a scale is used (range 1-5) that until everyone can get to a 3 (midway point) we don't move until group can get to some level of

understanding. Oregon is nationally known for being a collaborative state. This was a very good thought for Bev to leave the group with. What a great way to continue the work in Oregon.
