Consider what might be appropriate for the popularity box section of your home page. You can use any of these section options alone, or in coordination with each other.

Sections Include:

- Three head/subhead color options
- The choice of an 80x80 or 187 x 65 image (the larger image will fill the width of the box)
- Linking from an image
- Links opening within a new browser window
- Body text, linked text, scrolling text, or a combination
