Round 1 Meetings

Meetings and project phase intended to:

- Present data sharing concept and rationale
- Identify issues, concerns, items of key interest from meeting attendees
- Document the findings from the meetings and share information

- Meetings to be held in several geographic areas
- Meetings to be held with key stakeholder groups including OGISA, Assessors, Surveyors

Initial Program Development

- Form a committee to develop the Data Sharing Partnership
- Develop program components assuring they address the findings from Round 1 Meetings
- Develop a governance model for the partnership
- Develop draft legislative package or administrative mechanisms for implementation
- Document Committee Recommendations

Round 2 Meetings

Meetings and project phase intended to:

- Present Data Sharing Partnership Committee recommendations
- Obtain feedback from meeting participants
- Modify Committee recommendations based on meeting feedback
- Document Partnership Plan

- Identify steps required to adopt and implement the program
- Conduct identified adoption steps
- Initiate partnership implementation
