OWRD presentation Bob Harmon Alyssa Mucken Ken Stahr Carl Wozniak	<p>Bob Devylder and Bob Harmon opened the presentation by describing ODWR's integrated (IS/GIS) management of over 100,000 water rights in Oregon.</p> <p>Alyssa traced a water right application through various agency processing steps, including use of ArcMap to locate a water right and respond to public inquiries.</p> <p>Ken focused on water availability, including how it is calculated; natural streamflow definition and estimation concepts were presented.</p> <p>Carl presented groundwater analysis concepts in describing the ODWR groundwater flow model.</p> <p>Accurate well location is an ongoing problem; locations are provided by drillers and an education program is attempting to improve matters.</p>

OGIC/GEO report Cy Smith	<p>Cy is seeking agency feedback for the DAS/GEO declaration of ESRI GIS software to be state standard. The state process requires the declaration first to be approved by OGIC, then the CIO Council; and finally an administrative rule is necessary.</p> <p>Cy is working on a GIS Professional Services agreement for the state. Forestry Emmor Nile	Annual agency GIS conference in early December, to include training for ArcGis 9.2. Wilson and Kilchis river LiDAR project, done through the Puget Sound LiDAR Consortium to USGS standard. The 300 sq. mile project fills in a gap so LiDAR coverage is continuous from Tillamook Bay to Mt. Hood - cost = \$.73/acre or \$468/sq. mi.			
DLCD Randy Dana	Watershed Sciences doing LiDAR work with South Slough area of Coos Bay.			
Fish & Wildlife Jon Bowers	Mapping of regulated hunting/fishing areas at 24k. GIS Strategic Plan for agency has been prepared. Described fish passage summit last September. Jon is heading up the effort to create a fish passage layer that will be a component of the Bioscience Framework theme.			
Geology Paul Staub	Senate Bill 2 work continues on seismic assessment of public buildings; still working on location data; final report due on 7/1/07. Work progressing on state Geologic layer within Geoscience theme. LiDAR data processing.
