Allocation of State Framework Funds	The allocation of the \$500,000 was discussed. Cy needs to present some details to OGIC on December 19 th .	Results for each are listed in the following rows.		
Cadastral	The Cadastral layer was discussed.	Will recommend that \$30,000 be allocated to ODF. Emmor will arrange for an intern to update the Public Ownership 1:100,000 layer. Cy will also notify OGIC that another \$50,000 will be necessary to complete the project in the next biennium.	Yes	Cy and Emmor
Hydro	Hydro was discussed.	OGIC approved \$15,000.	No	
Elevation	Elevation was discussed but no money will be allocated.	Cy will report to OGIC that Henry Wolter's agency has some money to put toward the elevation layer during this biennium. The estimated cost of completion is \$75,000.	Yes	Cy
Admin. Boundaries	Administrative Boundaries was discussed. The need to develop an inventory of needs and requirements was discussed.	OGDC Staff will do an inventory of needs. Cy will recommend that \$50,000 be allocated to Employment to hire an Intern to collect the data and register with GCDB.	Yes	Cy
Cultural	Cultural was discussed. Statewide address point coverage needs to be developed. Who should do this was discussed.	Cy will report to OGIC that a Cultural Committee will be developed. This committee will decide the best way to create an implementation plan and the appropriate group to assign to development of a prototype.	Yes	Cy

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Transportation	Transportation was discussed. ODOT's Project Proposal for the Framework GIS layer was reviewed.	The Transportation Committee will be asked to review the Wasco County Pilot results. It was recommended that Ken Dueker's white paper be finalized. Cy will report to OGIC that the \$200,000 allocation has not been decided, and that a proposal is in place to extend the pilot. The FIT will decide if that is appropriate.	Yes	Cy
Orthoimagery	Orthoimagery was discussed. A master contract vehicle is being developed for local governments to use to purchase year 2000 orthos. The \$105,000 allocated would only pay for 1/10 th of the states' DOQs. 25-30 meter multi-spectral satellite imagery also needs to be purchased.	Different approaches to dealing with Orthoimagery will be discussed with OGIC, most specifically, whether to purchase DOQs or hire a consultant to do a requirements analysis as part of developing a long-term plan.
