

OGEOF Meeting Notes

May 14, 1998

Meeting Summary

The OGEOF meeting was held at the SSCGIS on May 14th, 1998. The meeting addressed two main issues: reports from the various committees and a Vision and Mission statement for OGEOF.

Committee Status Reports

Taxlot Committee

Scott Jackson was not able to attend the meeting so no report was given.

Hydrologic Committee

Bob Harmon handed out a revised attribute list and discussed the changes that had been made to it. He finished his report by telling the group that the watershed delineation group had not been able to meet.

Oregon Terrain Information System Committee (OTIS)

Emmor Nile was unable to attend the meeting. Nancy Tubbs showed the committee a status map.

Orbits Committee

The orbits committee reported that most of their previous meeting had been used to discuss issues necessary to creating a data transfer standard. Most of their discussions revolved around selecting attributes for the transfer standard. They also spent considerable time discussing whether to use a route or segment based system. After much discussion they settled on a route based system.

Vision Statement

During the discussion on the Vision Statement it was determined that a group of individuals would get together and create a draft white paper on what we wanted to accomplish with the Oregon Framework effort. This group would be responsible for drafting a vision statement by the next meeting with the white paper completed by the end of September.

Baseline Presentation

Fred Weigman reported on the current status of the baseline conversion effort. He presented a series of maps showing what was available and what had not yet come in.
