

OGEOF Meeting Notes

June 9, 1998

Meeting Summary

The OGEOF meeting was held at the SSCGIS on June 9th, 1998. The meeting focused on committee reports. Nancy Tubbs concluded the meeting by giving a brief report on framework efforts underway in other states.

Committee Status Reports

Taxlot Committee

Scott Jackson reported that the taxlot committee was working on a demonstration combining taxlot data from various sources. They will present the finished product to OGIC during its July meeting. The taxlot group is looking for funding to do a pilot project combining taxlot data from Polk, Linn, Washington, Clatsop, Benton, Lane, Part of Portland and possibly Deschutes counties. Scott finished his report by informing OGEOF that a memo was being drafted for the director of Revenue educating her on the work of the taxlot committee.

Hydrography Committee

Bob Harmon reported that Ken Bierly (GWEB) had inquired about whether the hydrography committee would address wetland data issues. After discussion the OGEOF committee decided that Bob would set up a meeting with the division of state lands (DSL), usgs-brd, and US fish and wildlife to discuss the issue. As part of that meeting Bob will suggest that 1) a wetlands specialist join the hydrography committee to advise on issues which involve overlap with wetlands, 2) that a separate wetlands group be set up to deal with the primary data issue. Bob continued the hydrography report by passing out a revised core hydrography features worksheet. The next issue addressed by the hydrography committee was its work on a draft MOU's. OGEOF decided that the

hydrography MOU should be used as a template for the other framework committees. In order to do this the hydrography committee will present the MOU to OGIC and run it past the Attorney Generals Office by September 1st. Bob concluded the hydrography report by mentioning that the watershed delineation subcommittee would be meeting on Friday to try and settle the location of the fifth field watershed boundaries for the west-side of the state. They eventually plan on delineating the east side of the state at 1:24,000 scale.

Oregon Terrain Information System Committee (OTIS)

Emmor started the OTIS report by displaying a graphic showing where 10-meter DEMs are being created. (An image of the map will be displayed on the SSCGIS webpage.) The committee hopes to receive the first of the 10-meter DEM data in about a year.

Orbits Committee

The Orbits committee had not met since the last OGEOF meeting.

Other States Framework Progress

Nancy Tubbs reported that the most of the framework efforts funded by FGDC had been theme specific. She concluded her remarks by mentioning that the review of next year's grants were completed and the recipients would be informed during the summer.
