

Minutes of April 14, 1998 GPL meeting

Meeting facilitated by Steve Barnett, SSCGIS.

Agency roundtable reports:

DLCD - Randy's doing system administration, Chad continuing his estuary project.

SSCGIS – project for Watershed Council in progress (demonstration later in meeting). The project involved reprojecting USGS digital raster graphics, and time efficiencies of reprojecting in Imagine versus ArcInfo were discussed.

OPRD Office of Preservation – report on archaeological site work and efforts to coordinate with federal and other state agencies.

Water Resources – report on updates of water right mapping, Klamath nearing completion, SE Oregon will be last.

ODOF – project on assessing Oregon's forest health, including baseline conditions, trends. Looking at 67 indicators of which 12 are spatial in nature. Working on forest vegetation layer for eastern Oregon.

DOR – Arc/Info work in coordination with Clatsop County. Report on meeting regarding the Oregon Land Information System: to strategize getting all players to table and how DOR can assist; discussion of pilot project concept. DOR's years of cost sharing with county assessors to develop mapping raised the question of the resulting parcel data ownership. Multnomah and Wasco counties completed.

Agriculture – report on Oregon Plan work for salmon recovery. Question on 100k GAP data and its cost. GAP data is from the National Biological Survey.

DEQ – Reports on training for DEQ employees, and Basin Assessments with data servers in regional offices. Web based data planned for Fall of 1998.

OPRD – report on rehab project for parks with \$15 million funding.

Geology – greater utilization of MapInfo for geologic mapping program. New map series of county Mined Land Reclamation Program permitted sites.

SSCGIS – Shapefiles have been added to the SSCGIS webpage. Discussion of metadata work to create a searchable node. Job rotation possibility announced for Mark Kinslow's position.

Project Demonstration - Jim Godfrey, SSCGIS

Jim described his work for the Watershed Council project in coordination with Ken Bierly. Project involves creating sets of six maps for each of ten watersheds. Jim presented six maps (1:50,000) done for the South Coast area: Base map; Land use (from 100k zoning); Ownership; Ownership with Land Use; Index of USGS quads; and USGS topographic maps (DRGs) covering the watershed (five quads spliced). Jim discussed aspects of putting the maps together including reprojecting and splicing the DRGs.

Committee reports -.

OGEOF – the group is modifying their mission statement

ORBITS – looking at feasibility of a single road coverage for Oregon

OTIS – in process of gathering 10 meter DEMs from various local/state/federal sources. Eventually these will be passed to SSCGIS for posting on web. Looking at bringing in SDTS 10 meter DEMs. Creation of an Information web site planned.

Hydro – Core features and attributes in draft form for hydrography point/line/polygon elements were distributed. Work on policy for GIS Plan mentioned. The Hydro list server at OWRD discussed.
