Raw UGB data is not in acceptable format, DLCD has had funds cut and have been unable to help. Riparian Field Data Collection Protocol project has been put on hold. Group is having difficulty reaching a consensus and the budget needs adjustments. Process for updating the plan includes assessment of accomplishments, update of goals and objectives, then set timelines for completion.</p> <p>New CIO – Don Fleming is on board as of Aug. 4. Don will be chairing the OGIC.</p> <p>Framework priorities need to be addressed again with an emphasis on funding priorities.</p> <p>Certification document that was presented to OGIC as an informational piece has generated a low level of comments and responses. Cy would like to know if there are concerns from GPL's represented agencies prior to the next OGIC meeting.</p> <p>A small group representing various segments of community has met to begin design of approach for addressing data access policies. Initial focus will be on Framework data.</p> | <p>Cy is recommending that the September OGIC be postponed based on need for more time for several important agenda items.</p> <p>Hoping to have recommendations ready for Dec. | DEQ | DEQ is developing a web interface for the Lab's LASAR (Laboratory Analytical and Storage Retrieval) database which contains air and water quality monitoring data. The interface is currently being tested. An upcoming project will be to make the LASAR database more compatible with the interface. ArcSDE and ArcIMS are the GIS tools being used to develop the interface. | | | |
| ODOT | Now has 100 plus end-users for AV3. Community Solutions Team has received an Executive Order to identify "shovel ready" sites – successfully using data for their part; however DEQ person is not having the same success. GPL group offered recommendations to sites that may help.
