A. Action Items

1. Correction to GPL minutes for January. In regards to the Hydro Standards Committee report in January, the REO is doing watershed delineation, not the BLM. Minutes then approved as corrected.

C. Reports

5. Hydrography Standards Committee Report: Bob H. reported on the efforts of this committee: 1) to pick up the efforts to complete the watershed delineation's currently being done 2) complete a hydro network at a 1:24k scale or and 3) to fulfill a responsibility to OGIC/OGISA and the Oregon Framework to develop attributes and exchange standard or guidelines.

6. NSGIC Report:

SSCGIS - NSGIC Survey is well underway, themes are being identified throughout the state. There has been a good response. Results will be out in March.

OWRD - Providing water rights mapping on the web, using arcexplorer to use various datasets.

7. OGIC Report: Oregon GIS Plan workshop is February 17th. Suggestion for the workshop were to tailor a demonstration for policy level people, survey policy level people prior to the meeting. Debbie discussed the plan to develop OGIC bylaws. Draft versions will be distributed.

8. IRICC

Emmor Nile reported on the IRICC meeting. He explained that an action item that concerns Oregon is the delineation of the 5th field watersheds. It was emphasized that

this effort was important, that the data layer was valuable, that GWEB has money to assist, and that someone needs to take it on. Points made were that the hydrologists should draw the boundary lines and should coordinate, that there needs to be pressure on REO to get it done, that it needs to be done to the sixth field, and that "NAME" as an attribute be used besides the number.

Emmor also explained that USGS has soft \$600,000 for next fiscal year, Oregon can influence completion of the orthophotography, 30 meter DEMs, and emphasize the need for 10 meter DEMs. On a related topic Emmor announced the Oregon Terrain Information System (OTIS) meeting on the January 22nd, lead by ODF. The effort will improve existing DEMs. Other efforts in the Oregon Geospatial Framework effort will include roads lead by ORBITS, DRGs lead by SSCGIS and PLS which currently has no agency lead.

9. SSCGIS Report

DAS has hired its new CIO, Don Mazziotti who has a strong private/public background. Arcview3 training is book for two months. We are entering into Baseline97 phase II, developing a marketing plan, doing work for DEQ on Map Objects application, and working with potentially 10 watershed council on various data layers.

10. Baseline97:

SSCGIS - Baseline97 minutes of the last meeting were approved, sent out and on the website. Regarding Framework data, it was suggested at an earlier GPL meeting, that quads be referenced by the old quad name, the new quad name and the Ohio Code. Fred explained that Theresa will be giving this to the FGDC meeting coming up.

11. Agency Reports

DSL - Using arcexplorer as well, transferring from UNIX to NT to benefit DSL staff.

ODA - Is currently focusing on adapting current data layers to the projection standard.

DOC - working to meet measure 13 objectives. Their Advisory council meet tomorrow to discuss pre-work training as well as post-work training for when inmates leave.

ODF - Has been asked to be a 3.1 beta testing testing site. Anyone else?

ODOT - has completed converting the MGE layer to arcinfo coverage, for rural @ 1:100K scale and urban @ 1:24k scale. Going to be available at the SSCGIS website.

ODF - add three full-time GIS position, one in Tillamook and two in Salem.

1. OLIS/Open Records Letter to OGIC

Letter is being shortened and made clearer. It was requested from the group that the letter be brought to GPL one more time.

2. GIS/IS Classification Template

Status, Bob H as sent GIS classification PD's to Theresa. Effort is to provide a template to agencies for the new GIS/IS classification positions for the coordinator and for the analyst. History: since OWRD and SSCGIS have or are currently rewriting the position descriptions, both Bob and Theresa have agreed to come up with the template.

Mike DeLaune demonstrated an xtools application available to agencies at www.odf.state.or.us/sfgis. He is working with ESRI to include it in the next release of Arcview. He wanted to begin to get data out to the field, and get them excited about GIS. They've begun to see its utility. He wanted to provide a direct link from those who are doing the analytical work to those who are making decisions.
