

TEST PLAN

INFORMATION SYSTEMS SPECIALIST 7 - 1487

1. Minimum Qualifications Screening
2. Those passing the minimum qualifications screening may receive a grade notice that shows a final score of "Qualified"; or
Agency may develop test questions and rating criteria at the time of recruitment.
3. Those with a score of "Qualified" - or those ranking highest on the test will be invited to participate in the next phase of the selection process.
4. If you are hired, certain knowledge and skills will be assessed during your trial service period.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Five years of professional consultative, technical, or administrative experience providing expert advice and leadership in planning, development, coordination, and implementation of information systems. Experience must include activities in (agency will specify infrastructure specialities); **and either**
 - (a) at least 30 quarter (20 semester) credits in computer science; **or**
 - (b) two more years of experience providing a knowledge of information systems theory and principles;

OR

- Agencies specify the education and/or experience that indicates possession of the knowledges and skills required as a minimum for the position.

NOTE: Agencies may develop written or other tests to ensure candidates have the required knowledges and skills.

15 quarter (10 semester) graduate-level computer science, software engineering, information systems, or equivalent credits may substitute for one year of the professional experience.
