1. Minimum Qualifications Screening
2. Agency may develop position-specific T&E test questions at the time of recruitment, or agency may develop T&E test questions on:
 - A. Public Health Theory, Principles, and Practices 60%
 - B. Education Theory, Principles, and Practices 20%
 - C. Communication 20%100%
3. Those ranking highest on the test will be invited to participate in the next phase of the selection process.
4. If you are hired, certain knowledge and skills will be assessed during your trial service period.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- A Bachelor's Degree in a health or education field **and**
- one year of public health experience.

A Master's Degree in a health, education or related field may substitute for the one year of public health experience.
