PUBLIC HEALTH EDUCATOR 2 - #2328

1. Minimum Qualifications Screening
2. Agency may:
 - develop test questions and criteria at the time of recruitment, or
 - use the core T&E test that has been developed on:

A. Public Health Education Theory, Principles, and Practices	20%
B. Consultation Principles and Practices	55%
C. Communication	<u>25%</u>
	100%
3. Those ranking highest on the test will be invited to participate in the next phase of the selection process.
4. If you are hired, certain knowledge and skills will be assessed during your trial service period.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- a Bachelor's degree in a health or education field **and** three years public health related experience;
OR
- a Master's degree in a health or education field **and** one year of public health related experience;
OR
- a Bachelor's degree **and** three years of leadership experience in a disease prevention or other health service (including mental health) organization at the local, state, or national level.

NOTE: Preference will be given for a Master's degree in a health or education field **and** one year of public health related experience.

HEALTH DIVISION EMS OPTION

You must possess:

- a current Oregon-certified Emergency Medical Technician – Paramedic (or obtain certification within 90 days of hire); **and**
- an Associates degree in Emergency Services Technology or equivalent (that included coursework in Anatomy & Physiology and Intro to Emergency Medical Services); **and**
- Four years of EMS experience, two years must have been in the health education field.

NOTE: You must attach copies of licenses, certification and transcripts as proof of above requirements.
