1. Minimum Qualifications Screening
2. Those passing the minimum qualifications screening may receive a grade notice that shows a final score of "Qualified"; or
Agency may develop test questions and rating criteria at the time of recruitment.
3. Those with a score of "Qualified" - or those ranking highest on the test will be invited to participate in the next phase of the selection process.
4. If you are hired, certain knowledge and skills will be assessed during your trial service period.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- college courses in a behavioral science major with a minimum of nine quarter hours (six semester hours) in courses such as test and measurements, statistics, educational learning and measurement, or appraisal of the individual; **AND**
- one year of experience administering and interpreting assessment tests such as achievement, aptitude, vocational, behavioral, motor, auditory discrimination, vision, interest and intelligence.

On your application, be specific in addressing your training and experience to the areas listed in the minimum qualifications.

Transcripts must be submitted for all required and/or related courses.
