MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- six years of graphic arts production experience, two years of which included providing direct technical consultation to customers and coordinating graphics design projects through to completion.
- Successful applicants will have experience in color separation and correction, technical illustration, and/or graphics or web software.
- A Bachelor's or Associate degree in Graphic Arts may substitute for two years of experience.
- A Bachelor's degree in Fine Arts with a minimum of 18 quarter (12 semesters) hours of graphic arts courses may substitute for one year of the experience.

Transcripts must be submitted for all required and/or related courses.

NOTE: Applicants invited for an interview should be prepared to present a personal portfolio of their work for review at that time.

WEB DESIGN SPECIALIST OPTION

- Three years of web design, authoring and maintenance which includes direct technical consultation with customers, and coordinating web design projects through implementation and subsequent maintenance, AND
- Experience on various computer platforms, scripting languages, software programs, web browsers, networks, scanners, and conducting research on new software programs.

Eighteen (18) months of desktop publishing, which includes compiling and production of information for wide dissemination (such as a newsletter), may substitute for 18 months of the required experience.

OR

Any combination of experience or education equivalent to two years of experience that typically supports the knowledge and skill requirements listed for the classification.

Note: The specific job-related experience or education requirements will be listed by the recruiting agency based on the position under recruitment.
