

## TEST PLAN

### CARTOGRAPHIC PROGRAM SPECIALIST - #3121

1. Minimum Qualifications Screening
2. Those passing the minimum qualifications screening may receive a grade notice that shows a final score of "Qualified"; or  
Agency may develop test questions and rating criteria at the time of recruitment.
3. Those with a score of "Qualified" - or those ranking highest on the test will be invited to participate in the next phase of the selection process.
4. If you are hired, certain knowledge and skills will be assessed during your trial service period.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- three years of drafting or cartography experience of which two years must include Oregon map making experience.

Experience must have provided:

- knowledge of laws and statutes regarding surveying, real property, and cartography.
- knowledge of drafting, survey, and cartographic terms and techniques.
- skill researching mapping information.
- skill reading and interpreting property documents such as deeds, survey reports, and legal descriptions.
- skill identifying discrepancies in, or related to, property documents.
