GENERAL MAINTENANCE MECHANIC - #4409

1. Minimum Qualifications Screening
2. Agency may:
 - develop test questions and criteria at the time of recruitment, or
 - use the core supplemental checklist test that has been developed on:
 - A. Trade Knowledge, Tools, and Equipment 100%
3. Those ranking highest on the test will be invited to participate in the next phase of the selection process.
4. If you are hired, certain knowledge and skills will be assessed during your trial service period.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- four years of experience maintaining, repairing, and fabricating parts for machinery, tools, and equipment such as automobiles, trucks, hydraulic systems, lift trucks, etc.; **OR**
- completion of an approved Mechanical Maintenance Apprenticeship Program.

OREGON YOUTH AUTHORITY OPTION:

- three years of experience operating, maintaining, and repairing facilities in one or more physical plants or building services, which included responsibility for the coordination of maintenance work.
