1. Minimum Qualifications Screening
2. Agency may develop position-specific T&E test questions at the time of recruitment, or agency may develop T&E test questions on:
 - A. Auditing Theory, Principles, and Practices 60%
 - B. Communication Skills 15%
 - C. Computer Application 10%
 - D. Management Practices 15%100%
3. Those ranking highest on the test will be invited to participate in the next phase of the selection process.
4. If you are hired, certain knowledge and skills will be assessed during your trial service period.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- A Bachelor's degree in a business-related field, such as business administration, public administration, finance, economics, computer science, etc., **AND** either;
- one year of auditing experience **OR** successful completion of the duties and training as an Oregon Governmental Auditor (Entry).

Twenty quarter hours of college course in a business or financial field such as the areas listed above **AND** two additional years of auditing experience may substitute for the degree.

Transcripts must be submitted for all required or related courses.
