

## TEST PLAN

### CORRECTIONAL CORPORAL - #6776

1. Minimum Qualification Screening
2. Agency may:
  - develop test questions and criteria at the time of recruitment, or
  - use the core T&E test that has been developed on:
    - A. Correctional Practices and Techniques 27%
    - B. Security Practices 47%
    - C. Communication (Reading and Writing) 26%
3. Those ranking highest on the test will be invited to participate in the next phase of the selection process.
4. If you are hired, certain knowledge and skills will be assessed during your trial service period.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- One year of experience in a correctional security setting where your primary duties were the care and custody of inmates and
- Be able to obtain, within one year, an Oregon Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) Correctional Certificate OR a Correctional Certificate from another government agency and
- Possess a High School Diploma or GED certificate; and
- Be 21 years of age or older; and
- United States Citizen
