iLearnOregon is a dynamic online learning and knowledge management tool, integrating general learning management functions (course catalog, registration, enrollments, transcripts and administration) as well as performance management tools such as individual development plans, skill assessments and performance evaluations. The statewide implementation, which started in March 2008, is executed in a way to ensure the system will fulfil its expected role as a **key tool** used to support the state of Oregon's training and workforce development efforts.

Currently, iLearnOregon includes:

- Over 45,000 user accounts!
- Over 6,000 active users!
- Over 600 active courses, including 31 on-line courses!
