Starting with Open enrollment, pebb.benefits will offer a variety of reporting tools for use by agencies and universities.

Reports Available 10/01

- **Not-yet-enrolled employees**
- **Dependent Certification**
- **IRS Dependents**

Beginning October first, agencies may create reports with records for: employees who have not enrolled in a medical plan for 2010; members who have not certified eligibility of dependents who will be age 19 up to 24 on or before January 1, 2010; and members who have IRS Dependents.

Report Available 11/01

- **Imputed Value**
 - **Domestic partner (partner's child)**
 - **Coverage in 2010**

Beginning November 1, agencies may create a report for records of employees whose enrollment includes coverage for a domestic partner or child of a domestic partner. The report will show the Imputed Value of the coverage for 2010.

Beginning December 1, agencies will be able to pull reports for: employees enrolled in optional life insurance for the employee, spouse or domestic partner; employees who have indicated eligibility for coverage of a dependent based on Michelle's Law; New Hires who have enrolled in PEBB plans; and employees who have indicated they are providing coverage for a dependent based on a national medical support notice or qualified medical support order.
