Agencies will be able to pull the following reports, with data updated to the time of the report, beginning the specified dates:

Oct. 1, 2009

Open Enrollment Medical Plan Un-Enrolls. Records of employees who have not enrolled in a medical plan for 2010

Dependent Certification. Records of members who have not certified eligibility of dependents who will be age 19 up to 24 on or before Jan. 1, 2010

IRS Dependents. Records of members who have IRS Dependents

Nov. 1, 2009

Imputed Value Report. Records of employees with coverage for a domestic partner or child of a domestic partner, showing the 2010 Imputed Value of the coverage

Dec. 1, 2009

Optional Life Enrollments. Records of employees enrolled in optional life insurance for the employee, spouse or domestic partner

Michelle's Law. Records of employees who have indicated eligibility for coverage of a dependent based on Michelle's Law

New Hire Enrollments. Records of New Hires who have enrolled in PEBB plans

NMSN/QMSO. Records of employees who have indicated they are providing coverage for a dependent based on a national medical support notice or qualified medical support order
